

**DESCENDANCY of JOHANN CARL GOTTLIEB KEIL (b 1812)
and
JOHANNA CHRISTIANE HILLER (b 1833)**

Carl's parents are not known to us
Christiane's parents were Carl "Charles" Hiller and Christiane Janisch

Note 1: material in smaller type is written by Barbara Ann Fisher, wife of KFE (Karl Frederick Edler Jr), while larger type material is from our family history data files maintained by KFE.

Note 2: as we've mentioned in other sections, spelling used to be quite variable. Surnames were often spelled phonetically, as determined by the person doing the writing. And, we even found a name spelled three ways within one document! We've attempted to show approximate pronunciation of some names, for the convenience of contemporary (2006) American readers not familiar with German. For example, Emilie is pronounced "Amelia" rather than "Emily". In many cases, spellings were later changed so the names would continue to be pronounced as they were originally.

Note 3: we've tried to show each person's birthplace as it was at the time. Political boundaries changed many times, so a birthplace could have been part of various countries at various times. Most of the ones in this Section later became part of Germany, and some are now in Poland. This can be confusing for a researcher, when he or she finds a tombstone "geboren Deutschland" or is told that someone "came from Germany".

Note 4: some place names are in German -- e.g., Preussen (Prussia), Schlesien (Silesia), and Pommern (Pomerania).

Note 5: we use the term "township" or "twp" for Wisconsin "towns", in order to avoid confusion on the part of readers unfamiliar with Wisconsin political subdivisions.

I. Johann Carl Gottlieb¹ Keil, usually known as Carl, was born 8 Nov 1812 Putichlau (near Liegnitz, now Legnica, Poland), Schlesien, Preussen.^{1,2,3} He was baptized 11 Nov 1812 and confirmed 11 Nov 1826.¹⁵

He married **Johanna Christiane Hiller**,² usually known as Christiane (pronounced Christianna), 8 Jan 1855. Born 8 Oct 1833 "Rücks" (probably Schlesien), she was baptized 25 Nov 1833 and confirmed 26 Sep 1847.¹⁵ Her parents were **Carl "Charles" Hiller** and **Christiane Janisch**.

Carl and Christiane and their three oldest children immigrated to America on the ship *Shakspeare* from Bremen, arriving in New York 29 Aug 1860.⁴ The passenger list shows Charles (age 47), Christina (age 27), Dorothea (age 9), Anna (age 4), Charles (age 2) and Paulina (age .11, infant).

Carl died 1898 Wrightstown Township, Brown Co WI, age about 86, and Christiane died 1907 Outagamie Co WI, age about 74. They were buried Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Cemetery, Kaukauna, Outagamie Co.²

FINDING OUR KEILS -- Carl was a farmer, and we knew he had lived in Scott Township, Sheboygan Co WI. We had, however, thought he was a tenant farmer and didn't own land of his own, and were discouraged trying to find much about the family. Fortunately, during our May 1999 trip to Wisconsin, we visited the Sheboygan County Historical Research Center in Sheboygan Falls WI. Imagine our excitement when we looked at an 1862 plat map of Sheboygan Co and found 40 acres in Section 24 of Scott Twp marked "C Kyle"!

The 1865 Real Estate Assessment Roll for the Town of Scott shows Carl Kile, with 40 acres valued at \$289.00. The various taxes, for state, county, town, county school district, school district, "RR", harbor improvement, and "CF", total \$7.48. His personal property was valued at \$60.00, with total tax \$1.59. In 1875, he was assessed for 80 acres valued at \$900.00. His personal property is shown as 3 horses (\$75), 8 cattle (\$60), 15 sheep (\$15), 4 swine (\$10), merchants stock (\$50), and 3 wagons (\$35), total \$245.00.

WHERE THEY LIVED -- Carl and Christiane later acquired an additional 40 acres. The location of the farm, in the southeast corner of the section, on the dividing line between Scott and Sherman twps, made it easy for us to drive by it. No buildings were visible, but the fields were being worked. It is bottom land, slightly rolling, and looks to us like good land. (Incidentally, Sherman Twp was originally Abbot Twp. Its name was changed sometime after the 1862 date of the plat mat, because the Abbot family, for whom it had been named, were Southern sympathizers.)

On 28 Feb 1876 Carl and Christiane purchased about 120 acres in Barton Twp, Washington Co WI, from Gerhard and Peter Ney Jr (brothers, both unmarried) for the sum of \$1400. (Gerhard and Peter had purchased the land from their parents in Mar 1874 for \$1400.) It is described as "N half of SW qtr (80 ac); also SW qtr of the SE qtr (abt 40 ac); excepting from the last described piece of land, so much as was deeded to the Northwestern Union Railway Company for their right of way; all situated in Section 27 in Twp 12 N of Range 19 East."²⁰ On 21 Aug 1885 Carl and Christiane sold the property for \$2600 to Charles Techtmann, who married their daughter Caroline Marie Amalie, page 9b-13. The family moved again, this time to Wrightstown Twp, Brown Co WI.

We obtained photocopies of some deeds in the Sheboygan Co courthouse, and now know there were a good many land transactions among family members during the period. The deeds for the 1876 purchase and 1885 sale were found in 2000 by Linda Martin in Washington Co land records.²⁰

WHERE THEY CAME FROM -- To our delight, the Research Center had transcriptions of many old records of St John Lutheran Church in tiny present day Sherman Center, Sheboygan Co WI, and provided information we hadn't had previously. We had spent much time fruitlessly trying to find our Keils in various churches in other parts of Scott Township and even in nearby counties. Earlier there just wasn't any reason to look in Sherman Twp, but now it's obvious St John was the nearest or most convenient church.¹⁵

According to these records, Carl was born in Putitsh, Christiane in "Rücks", and the first three children in Pühlau. These are tantalizing clues, and have led to *tentative* identification of villages or landed estates near present-day Legnica and Wrocław, Poland. We hope that finding more about their birthdates and birthplaces may lead us to more about their parents and/or other family members.

CHRISTIANE'S FAMILY -- We believe her parents were Carl "Charles" Hiller and Christiane Janisch. They had at least five children besides Christiane, and Carl later married again and had five more children. See Section 9a for more about this family and our search for them.

DOROTHEA -- Until just recently, we didn't know anything about her except for her name (pronounced "Dora-taya") on the list of passengers. We thought perhaps she died before any other record was made, or perhaps she was a child of Carl's from an earlier marriage not known to us, or perhaps she was the child of another relative who had arranged for Carl and Christiane to bring her to America.

Then we found "Dorothea Hiller" among the sponsors of Carl's and Christiane's fifth child, and thought this might be our Dorothea but were concerned that she might have been too young, if her age on the passenger list was correct. Later, after examining land deeds, we found "Dorothea Voelksen, formerly Hiller" as an heir of Carl Hiller, and now believe she was indeed a younger sister of Christiane's. We would like to know more about her.

A. Anna Susanne Emilie² Keil, born 3 Jan 1856 Pühlau,¹⁵ near Breslau, Schlesien (now Wrocław, Poland), married Gustav Emil **Priebe**

B. Karl August² Keil, born 5 Mar 1857 Pühlau,¹⁵ Preussen, married Adeline Henrietta Elizabeth **Moede** -- [see page 9b-7](#).

We haven't been able to find Pühlau on any maps, so we aren't certain whether it was in Pommern (in the northern part of Preussen) or in Schlesien (in the southern part of Preussen). If in Pommern, then the family made a significant move from the south to the north between the births of the first two children. Not at all impossible, but we are curious what the reason for such a move might have been.

C. Johanna Christiane Pauline² “Paulina” Keil, born 2 Nov 1858 Pühlau,¹⁵ Preussen, married August **Johns** -- [see page 9b-8](#).

D. Emma Antonie² Keil, born 25 Nov 1861 Scott Twp, Sheboygan Co WI, married William **Techtmann** -- [see page 9b-9](#).

E. Louisa Ottilie Christiane² “Lizzie” Keil, born 19 Mar 1863 Scott Twp, Sheboygan Co WI, married Carl **Staniske** -- [see page 9b-32](#).

F. Caroline Marie Amalie² “Mary” Keil, born 24 Feb 1865 Scott Twp, Sheboygan Co WI,^{1,8} married Charles **Techtman** -- [see page 9b-13](#).

G. Bertha Mathilda² Keil, born 21 Oct 1866 Scott Twp, Sheboygan Co WI, married Johann Franz Adam “John” **Techtmann** -- [see page 9b-16](#).

H. Auguste Emilie² Keil, born 14 Nov 1868 Scott Twp, Sheboygan Co WI, married Johann Paul Gerhardt **Buelow** -- [see page 9b-17](#).

I. Ernst Robert² Keil was born 24 Jan 1871 Scott Twp, Sheboygan Co WI, and baptized 5 Feb 1871. He died 8 Sep 1871, age 7 months 15 days, and was buried 10 Sep 1871.¹⁵

We didn't know about little Ernst Robert until we found the records of St John Lutheran Church, Sherman Center, Sheboygan Co WI, on our May 1999 trip. Although we didn't find a tombstone for him, we think this baby would surely have been buried in the St John cemetery. Many stones are broken and/or lying in piles, and there is a large area where it looks to us like there are graves even though there are no markers.

J. Charles (Carl?) Richard² Keil, born 29 May 1874 Scott Twp, Sheboygan Co WI, married Wilhelmina A Zellmer -- [see page 9b-18](#).

A. Anna Susanne Emilie² "Susanna" **Keil** was born 3 Jan 1856 Pühlau,¹⁵ near Breslau, Schlesien, Preussen, now Wrocław (pronounced Vrotswof), Poland. She was baptized 8 Jan 1856 and confirmed 28 Apr 1870.¹⁵

She married Gustav Emil **Priebe**, usually called Emil, 13 May 1883 St John Evangelical Lutheran Church, Wrightstown, Brown Co WI.^{3,5} He was born 26 May 1844, Boraniec, Posen, Preussen. His parents were Friedrich Gottfried Priebe (pronounced "Pree-bee") and Anna Christina **Klebs** (Kleps?).

In 1900 Emil is shown as owning a farm in Poysippi, Waushara Co WI.

Susanna died 4 Nov 1925 Oshkosh, Winnebago Co WI, age 69. Emil died 30 Nov 1936 Fisk, Utica Twp, Winnebago Co, age 91. They were buried Doty Street Lutheran Cemetery, Oshkosh.

EMIL'S FIRST FAMILY -- He married Pauline **Gudirian** 14 Oct 1869 Berlin, Green Lake Co WI; five children, all born Berlin. In 1870, Emil is shown as a laborer, living Oshkosh.

1. William **Priebe** was born about 1868; we don't know anything else about him.

The other four children all died within ten terrible days in 1880, probably from an epidemic, and were buried Oakwood Cemetery, Berlin:

2. Clara Mathilda **Priebe** was born 30 Apr 1871. She died 17 Oct 1880, age 9.

3. Earnest **Priebe** was born 9 May 1873. He died 14 Oct 1880, age 7.

4. Albert Bernard **Priebe** was born 20 Aug 1875. He died 24 Oct 1880, age 5.

5. Minnie Helen **Priebe** was born 1878. She died 17 Oct 1880, age about 2.

It is hard to imagine how Emil and Pauline survived October of 1880. They divorced before 13 May 1883.

1. Fredrick Wilhelm Edward³ **Priebe**, born 30 Aug 1883 Wrightstown, Brown Co WI, married Lydia Louise **Zarling** 4 Apr 1909. He died after 1977.

They had at least one child, who in 1994 was living and had a living spouse, according to Ancestral File.

2. Charlotte Louise³ "Lottie" **Priebe** was born 3 Apr 1885 Wrightstown, Brown Co WI. She died 25 May 1966, age 81, buried Peace Lutheran Cemetery, Oshkosh.

3. Florence Mathilda³ "Flora" **Priebe** was born 16 Nov 1886 Poysippi, Waushara Co WI. She died 8 Oct 1988 Dayton, Montgomery Co OH, age 101, buried Peace Lutheran Cemetery, Oshkosh.

4. William Walter³ "Willie" **Priebe** was born 19 Jan 1888 Poysippi. He died before 1977.

5. Ernest Leopold³ **Priebe** was born 19 Oct 1889 Poysippi. He died 14 Jul 1956 Wood, Vernon Co WI, age 66, buried Peace Lutheran Cemetery, Oshkosh.

6. Paul Emil³ **Priebe** was born 16 Feb 1891 Poysippi. He died 27 Sep 1966 Wood Vets Home, Milwaukee WI, age 75, and was buried Ellenwood Cemetery, Oshkosh.

7. Bertha Louise³ **Priebe** was born 17 Mar 1894/95 Poysippi. She died after Mar 1977.

I. Christian **Priebe** married Elise **Jahnke**. They were both born about 1785, probably in Posen, Preussen.

A. Friedrich Gottfried **Priebe**, born 10 Jan 1805 Posen, Preussen, married Elisabeth **Kempf** about 1825; three daughters born Baerenbruch, Schubin, Posen. The second and third ones may have been twins. Born about 1805 Posen, Elisabeth died about 1828, age about 23, possibly at or shortly after their birth.

1. Juliane **Priebe** was born 1825.
2. Caroline Justina **Priebe** was born May 1828. She died 7 Dec 1829, age about 1½.
3. Wilhelmina **Priebe** was born 1828.

Secondly, Friedrich married Anna Christina **Klebs (Kleps?)** 7 Sep 1828; nine children. She is shown as Caroline in the 1870 census of Oshkosh. The first six children were born Baerenbruch, Schubin, Posen, but none lived more than 3 months.

4. Anna Charlotte **Priebe** was born 25 Sep 1829. She died 14 Nov 1829, age six weeks.
5. Susanna Karolina **Priebe** was born 30 May 1832. She died 3 Jun 1832, age about 4 days.
6. Eva Rosina **Priebe** was born 14 Aug 1833. She died 16 Nov 1833, age 3 months.
7. Henriette Amelie **Priebe** was born 10 Dec 1834. She died 18 Dec 1834, age about 8 days.
8. (--?--) **Priebe**, an unnamed son, was born 2 Dec 1836. He died 3 Dec 1836, age about one day.
9. Erdmann Friedrich **Priebe** was born 30 Nov 1838. He died 9 Dec 1838, age about 9 days.

It is hard to imagine Anna Christina's life during these years, especially the autumn of 1829, when her first child was born and died, and her stepchild died about three weeks later. Then she had five more children and each died. Her last three children survived, below.

Friedrich died 19 Oct 1884, age 79. Born 24 Jun 1810 Neudorf, Schubin, Posen, Anna Christina died 3 Jan 1898, age 88. They were buried Riverside Cemetery, Oshkosh.

10. Friedrich Eduard **Priebe**, born 11 Jun 1841 Boraniec, Posen, married Barbara **Seidler** 1864/1865; six children. Born 12 May 1838, she died 2 Jan 1918, age 79. He died 21 Nov 1921 Oshkosh, age 80. They were buried Riverside Cemetery, Oshkosh.

a. Emma Amelia **Priebe**, born 1864/1865 Milwaukee, married George N **Cook**; five children. She died about 1918, age about 53.

b. Fred **Priebe**, born 25 May 1865 Oshkosh, married Ida **Springhorn**; two children. He died 21 Mar 1938, age 72, buried Riverside Cemetery.

c. Anna M **Priebe**, born Jun 1868 Oshkosh, married Grant **Gill**; children not known to us. She died Dec 1918 Bloomsburg, Columbia Co PA, age 50.

d. John Ralph **Priebe**, born 5 Jul 1869 Oshkosh, married Helen [Priebe]; two children. He died 13 Jul 1955, age 86, buried Memorial Park Cemetery, Evanston, Cook Co IL.

e. Henry August **Priebe**, born 23 Oct 1878 Oshkosh, married Elise Emilie Maria **Wockenfuss**; five children. He died 12 Jul 1960, age 81, buried Riverside Cemetery, Oshkosh.

f. Ida Louise **Priebe**, born 7 Mar 1882 Oshkosh, married William **Davis**; four children. They were divorced. Secondly, she married Erwin M **Brewer**; four children. She died 2 May 1981, age 99, buried Lake View Memorial Park, Oshkosh.

11. Gustav Emil **Priebe**, born 26 May 1844 Boraniec, Posen, married Pauline **Gudirian** and married Anna Susanne Emilie **Keil**

12. Adolph H **Priebe**, born 8 Sep 1847 Posen, married Augusta Carolina **Hansen** 3 Jun 1877 Newport RI; ten children. Born 1 Jun 1854 Sweden, she died 21 Apr 1931, age 76. He died 25 Dec 1943, age 96. They were buried Riverside Cemetery, Oshkosh.

a. Alida May "Lydia" **Priebe** was born 14 Jan 1878 Newport RI. She died 21 Mar 1950, age 72, buried Lake View Memorial Park, Oshkosh.

b. Mary Louise **Priebe** was born 1 Mar 1880 Poysippi. She died 4 Jun 1960, age 80, buried Riverside Cemetery, Oshkosh.

c. Sara Bertha **Priebe** was born 16 Jan 1882. She died 30 Sep 1957, age 75, buried Riverside Cemetery.

d. Max Paul **Priebe** was born 14 Oct 1883. He died 6 Oct 1921, age 37, buried Riverside Cemetery.

e. Titus Martin **Priebe** was born 1 Jan 1885. He died 17 Jul 1949, age 64, buried Riverside Cemetery.

f. Evelyn Eva **Priebe** was born 12 Jan 1887 Leon Twp, Waushara Co WI. She died 24 Mar 1949, age 61, buried Milwaukee WI.

g. Adolph Gustav **Priebe** was born 5 Sep 1888. He died 29 Mar 1966, age 77, buried Brushville Cemetery, Brushville, Waushara Co WI.

h. Clara Flora **Priebe** was born 8 Nov 1890. She died Nov 1940, age about 50, buried Lake View Memorial Park, Oshkosh.

i. Walter Armin **Priebe** was born 12 Jul 1893 Oshkosh. He died 29 Jun 1970, age almost 77, buried Hilltop Cemetery, Saxeville, Waushara Co WI.

j. Harry Earl **Priebe** was born 28 Aug 1895 Winnebago Co WI.

B. Karl August² **Keil** was born 5 Mar 1857 Pühlau,¹⁵ Preussen, and was baptized 15 Mar 1857. He married Adeline Henrietta Elizabeth **Moede** 4 May 1889 St John Evangelical Lutheran Church, Wrightstown, Brown Co WI;^{3,5} at least five children. We think she had immigrated to America with her parents, John Moede and Augusta C **Sill**.

In 1900 Karl August was a farmer in Deering Precinct, Chehalis Co WA (later Grays Harbor Co). In 1910 he was the operator of a small hotel (15 boarders) in Cosmopolis, Grays Harbor Co. He died 11 Oct 1917 Cosmopolis, age 60, buried Cosmopolis.

In 1920 Adeline was the operator of a small hotel, or perhaps a boarding house, on F Street in Cosmopolis. Before her husband's death, she had helped him operate what appears to have been a slightly larger establishment in the same town, but it may have been destroyed by fire. Lodgers were apparently mostly saw mill employees.

Born 11 Jul 1866 Ziegenitz, Pommern, Adeline died 30 Jul 1938 Cosmopolis, age 72, buried Cosmopolis.

At some point the spelling of the family name was changed from Moede to Meade. We think that's why it took us so long to find much information about them.

ADELINE'S PARENTS were buried Cosmopolis. Born about 1835, John Moede died about 1895, age about 60. Born 10 Mar 1840, Augusta C Sill died 12 Jul 1924, age 84.

1. Clara Bertha Augusta³ **Keil**, born 11 Apr 1890, Latesse, Latah Co ID, married Charles Thomas **Bryan** 1 Nov 1907 Presbyterian Parsonage, Centralia, Lewis Co WA; two children. Born 30 Dec 1883, he was killed 20 Dec 1935 Auburn WA, age almost 52, in a train wreck on the Northern Pacific Railroad.

Secondly, she married (--?--) **Williams**. She died 2 Nov 1946, age 56, buried Centralia, Lewis Co WA.

a. Harry⁴ **Bryan** was born 30 Sep 1908, or possibly born about 1911 (age 9 in 1920 census).

b. Ethel Lavinia⁴ **Bryan** was born 10 Jan 1910.

2. Harry Gottlieb³ **Keil**, born 21 Sep 1891 North River WA, married Sarah A "Sadie" **Conder** 29 May 1923; children not known to us. He died 9 Oct 1970 Aberdeen, Grays Harbor Co WA, age 79. Born 2 Dec 1895, she died 12 Apr 1981 Boise ID, age 85.

3. Carl Hermann³ **Keil**, born 28 Jun 1894 North River WA, served in the US Army in WW2. He married Pauline **Amber** 14 Feb 1948; children not known to us. He was an engineer who worked on construction of the Alaskan Highway. She died 14 Dec 1957. He died 13 Nov 1976 Long Beach, Pacific Co CA, age 82, buried Cosmopolis.

4. Wilhelm Frederick³ "Quick" **Keil**, born 5 Feb 1897 North River WA, married Betty **Walezak** before 1930; children not known to us. She died 11 Feb 1969. He died March 1975 Seattle, King Co WA, age 78.

5. Lena Gay Elizabeth³ **Keil**, born 18 April 1901 North River WA, married Karl Henry **Bruin** 29 Oct 1946; children not known to us. She died 21 Jan 1970 Seattle, King Co WA, age 68, buried Cosmopolis.

C. Johanna Christiane Pauline² "Paulina" Keil, was born 2 Nov 1858 Pühlau,¹⁵ Preussen, and baptized 14 Nov 1858. She married August **Johns** 18 July 1885 St John Evangelical Lutheran Church, Wrightstown, Brown Co WI.³ His parents were Friederich John and Johanna **Bohrtz**.

Paulina died 2 Jan 1900 in WI, age 41. Born 3 May 1856 Pommern, August died 25 Jul 1931 Auburndale, Wood Co WI, age 75. They were buried St John Lutheran Cemetery, Wrightstown.

Note: the name "Johns" was pronounced "Yones" but, in later generations of the family, it came to be pronounced "Jones" and its spelling changed accordingly.

1. Sarah Louisa Lenora³ Johns/Jones, born 21 Jun 1886 in WI, married William **Schroeder**; three daughters, including the one below.

Born 31 May 1871 Germany, he died about 1940 near Marshfield, Wood Co WI, age about 69, buried Hewitt Cemetery, Hewitt, Wood Co WI.

a. Grace E⁴ Schroeder was born 28 May 1918 Auburndale Township, Wood Co WI, and graduated from Auburndale High School. She was employed at Pick Manufacturing Company and at Amity Leather. She married Paul O **Hackbarth** 29 Nov 1939; no children.

Born 28 Jul 1900, Paul died 24 Apr 1953, age 52. Grace died 11 Jan 1998 West Bend, Washington Co WI, age 81. They were buried Washington Co Memorial Park, Washington Co.

2. Robert³ Johns was born 20 May 1887 in WI.

3. Fred³ "Fritz" Johns was born 4 Jan 1889 in WI.

4. Arthur William Albert³ Johns, born 18 Mar 1891 Marshfield, Brown Co WI, married Cora **Horsens** 17 Jun 1914. Her parents were James/Jens Horsens and Sophia **Henningsen**. Born 26 May 1891 Green Valley, Shawano Co WI, Cora died 8 Jan 1960, Morrison, Brown Co WI, age 68. Arthur died 7 Aug 1967, Morrison, age 76. They were buried Zion Lutheran Cemetery, Wayside, Brown Co.

Three children, the two below plus a son born 1931 in WI, who married and had seven children.

a. Margaret Sophie Alice⁴ Johns, born 27 Jul 1915 Carlton, Kewaunee Co WI, married Wallace Peter **Rosera** 7 Oct 1939 Montpelier, Kewaunee Co WI; four children born Green Bay, Brown Co WI. He was born 15 Dec 1916. She died 27 Mar 1999 Green Bay, age 83.

b. Bernice Lucille⁴ Johns, born 29 Apr 1917, Sandy Bay, Kewaunee Co WI, married Donald Christian **Emich** 23 Sep 1939 Kewaunee Co WI; one son (married; three children). Born 27 Sep 1916, Donald died 15 Jun 1972, age 55. She died 26 Nov 1996, Westborough, Worcester Co MA, age 79, and was buried Floral Lawn Memorial Gardens, Battle Creek, Calhoun Co MI.

Their son has been most helpful to us in providing information about the Johns/Jones family.

5. Emma Mathilda Henrietta³ Johns, born 17 Jan 1893, married Christ **Frandsen**; children not known to us. She died 8 Mar 1930 Fairview Hospital, Minneapolis, Hennepin Co MN, age 37, buried St John Lutheran Cemetery, Wrightstown, Brown Co WI.

6. Wilhelm Theodor³ Johns was born 5 Mar 1895. He died 6 Jun 1913 DePere, Brown Co WI, age 18.

**EMMA ANTONIE KEIL (b 1861) and WILLIAM TECHTMANN (b 1860)

Emma's parents were Johann Carl Gottlieb Keil and Johanna Christiane Hiller

William's parents were Johan Heinrich Techtmann and Marie Abel

D. Emma Antonie² **Keil** was born 25 Nov 1861 Sherman, Scott Township, Sheboygan Co WI, and was confirmed 11 Apr 1875. She married William **Techtmann** 14 Jun 1885 St John's Lutheran Church, West Bend, Washington Co WI; two children born West Bend.⁷

His parents were Johan Heinrich "Henry" Techtmann and Marie **Abel**, pages 9b-10 and 9b-14.

William was born 18 Nov 1860 Barton Township, Washington Co WI, and lived there until 1924 when he and Emma moved to West Bend. He died 28 Mar 1934 West Bend, age 73. She died 20 Jul 1949 West Bend, age 87. They were buried Union Cemetery, West Bend.²

According to his obituary, "...Mr Techtmann was a man of many noble traits of character -- honest and industrious, amicable and cheerful, and an ideal husband and father. He had many friends, all strongly attached to him..."

EMMA'S BIRTHPLACE -- We're not certain of the significance of the statement that Emma was born in "Sherman, Scott Township" since there is no village or town of Sherman in Scott Twp. We know her parents had a farm in Scott Twp in 1862, but we don't know when they acquired it. If Emma was born on the farm, "Sherman" could refer to the nearest post office, Sherman (now Adell).

Alternatively, it is *possible* that the family may have been in Sherman at the time Emma was born, before moving to their farm. If so, however, she was actually born in Abbot (now Sherman) Twp, not Scott Twp.

THEIR FARM -- Cousins showed us the farms of William and his brothers when we visited Wisconsin in May 1999. We enjoyed seeing William and Emma's farm, and were pleased to see that the present owner, who had lived there 25 years, had a fine large stand of Christmas trees nearly ready for harvest.

1. John Henry³ Techtmann, born 12 Aug 1889, married Otilie Catherine "Tillie" **Schaefer** 4 Jun 1913; no children.¹⁹ Her parents were Christian Schaefer and Wilhelmina **Prost**.

John died 10 Jul 1976 Cedar Lake Home, West Bend, age 86. Born 5 May 1889, Tillie died 26 Dec 1977, age 88. They were buried Peace Church Cemetery, Kewaskum, Washington Co WI.

They lived on his parents' farm in Barton Twp 15 years until 1928, when they moved to Milwaukee. In 1970 they went to Cedar Lake.

2. William Henry³ Techtmann, born 20 Sep 1892,⁹ married Esther M **Landvatter** -- see page 9b-19.

I. Johann Christof^f Techtmann was born 26 Jul 1800, Vinstedt (pronounced "Finsted"), Hanover, perhaps in or near Melzingen. His wife Catharina's name was probably Maria Catharina Dorothea **Stern**, and she probably was called Maria in her later years. Their four sons, shown below, were followed by an infant daughter who did not survive.²⁶

With his wife and sons, Johann Christof emigrated from Bremen on the ship *Atlantic*, arriving New York 21 Sep 1855^f after a 51 day voyage. On the passenger list, the family name is spelled "Tegtmann".

In the 1860 census, he is shown as a farmer in Barton Twp, Washington Co WI, with real estate worth \$900 and personal property \$181, substantial in those days.

Catharina was born about 1804 (she is shown as age 52 on the passenger list) in Hanover. She died about 1862, age about 58, but we don't know where she was buried.

He married Elizabeth [**Mueller**] 16 Jun 1863. Born about 1809, she died about 1891, age about 82, and was buried St Mary's Immaculate Conception Cemetery, Barton, Washington Co WI.²⁰

He died 16 Jul 1891, age 91, and was buried Union Cemetery, West Bend, Washington Co WI, near the grave of his son Henry, between Henry's second and third wives.²

Note: three grandsons of Johann Christof and Catharina Techtmann married three daughters of Carl and Christiane Keil.

ELIZABETH was the widow of Mathias Mueller, who died about 1862 Washington Co WI. She and Mathias had four children: Maria Anna Mueller (married (--?--) Saenger, she died before 1862); Elizabeth Mueller (born 9 Jun 1844, married Johann Techtmann, page 9b-12); Katharina Mueller (married (--?--) Olinger); and Carl Paul Mueller.²⁰

A great-great-grandson of Johann Christof says he understands that Johann Christof was a pauper when he died. We don't know what happened, or anything else about this.

A. Johann Heinrich² "Henry" Techtmann was born 28 Oct 1828 Vinstedt, Hanover. At age 27 in 1855, he immigrated to America with his parents.⁴ He settled Barton Twp, Washington Co WI, where he lived the rest of his life. He married Marie **Abel** (pronounced "Ah-bul") about 1858.

In the 27 Jun 1860 census, he is shown as a day laborer, age 31, with personal property worth \$123, in West Bend Twp. (A day laborer was one who went out to work for others.)

Born 20 Mar 1830 "Mechlenburg, Deutschland", Marie died 15 Sep 1882,² age 52.

Henry married Katharina **Weller** (pronounced "Vell-er") 10 Jun 1883 in WI. Born 12 Mar 1834 "Kras Hessen", she died 20 Mar 1885,² age 51.

He married Anna Louise "Louisa" **Unger** (pronounced "Ung-er") 12 Oct 1885 in WI. She was born 27 Apr 1843 Pommern.²

He died 18 Aug 1917 West Bend, Washington Co WI, age 88. Louisa died 1922, age about 79. Henry and all three wives were buried Union Cemetery, West Bend.²

In 1999 there were several tombstones for this family in rows 30 and 31 in Union Cemetery, including 2 flat ones, 2 upright (one of which appeared new) and one pillar, some of which appeared to be duplicates.

Henry's says "HEINRICH TECHTMAN / GEBOREN IN DEUTSCHLAND / IN KOENIGREICH HANOVER / DEM LAND ROSSTEI / LÜNEBERG / DEM AMT MEDIGEN / DEM ORT FINSTEDT / 28 OCT 1828 / HAT ER DAS LICHT DER WELT."

1. Marie³ "May" Techtmann was born about 1859 Barton Twp, Washington Co WI.⁶ She is listed on the 1860 census as "Mary", age one year.

2. William³ **Techtman**, born 18 Nov 1860 Barton Twp, married Emma Antonie **Keil** -- [see page 9b-9](#).

3. Henry S³ **Techtman**, born 1 Jan 1864 West Bend, Washington Co, married Hermine "Minnie" **Scheid** 22 Nov 1887; six children.

Born 17 May 1869, Minnie died, age 70, on 22 Nov 1939, her 52nd wedding anniversary and the same day her father had died 37 years earlier.⁴ Henry died 24 Nov 1946, age 82. They were buried Union Cemetery, West Bend.

On our May 1999 trip to Wisconsin, our cousins showed us the farms of Henry and his two brothers. Henry and Minnie's house is in a sheltered location below a hill, which was especially appreciated during bad weather. Some of the children in the family teasingly referred to him as "Henry in the hole". The present owners have well maintained the beautiful log house.

4. Elizabeth³ "Eliza" **Techtman**, born about 1864 Barton Twp,⁶ married Bernhardt **Fischer**; children not known to us.

5. Johann Franz Adam³ "John" **Techtman**, born 3 Apr 1868 Barton Twp, married Bertha Mathilda **Keil** -- [see page 9b-16](#).

B. Wilhelm² **Techtman**⁹ was born 4 Sep 1831, Epsdorf (now Ebstorf), near Vinstedt, Hanover. He apprenticed to a shoemaker. At age 24 in 1855, he immigrated to America with his parents.⁴

He married Fredericka Christiane **Ockler** 4 Jun 1859;²⁶ six daughters. Fredericka was born 23 May 1839 Gessets, Preussen. Her parents were Tobias Ockler and Erdmund **Weber**. For 15 years Wilhelm was a shoemaker in Milwaukee and Muskego.

1. Louise³ **Techtman**, born about 1860, married Karl **Wilde**; children not known to us.

2. Emma³ **Techtman** was born about 1861.

3. Alice³ **Techtman** was born about 1863. She died about 1864, age probably one year or less.

4. Mary³ **Techtman** was born about 1868.

5. Anna³ **Techtman** was born about 1875.

6. Lydia³ **Techtman** was born about 1878.

C. Heinrich² "Henrick" **Techtman**⁹ was born about 1835, probably Vinstedt, Hanover. At age 20 in 1855, he immigrated to America with his parents.⁴ He married Minna **Guhl**; three children. He died 30 Aug 1864, age about 29.

Minna later married Ludwig **Hembrook**; four sons: William, Henry, Herman, and Otto.^{18,26}

1. Charles³ **Techtman**, born 5 Feb 1859 So Milwaukee WI, dropped the final "n" from his name. He married Caroline Marie Amalie "Mary" **Keil** -- [see page 9b-13](#).

2. Robert³ **Techtman** changed his name to **Deckman**.²⁶

3. Anna³ **Techtman** married John **Krueger**.²⁶

D. Johann² "John" **Techtmann** was born 22 Oct 1842 Vinstedt, Amt Metigan, Hanover,¹⁶ and came to America with his parents at age 13 in 1855.⁴ On the 15 Jun 1860 census he is shown as a farm laborer, age 19, with his parents in Barton Twp. (A farm laborer was one who worked on the farm where he lived.) He volunteered 12 Oct 1861 in Co F, 9th Wisconsin Infantry.¹⁸

He married Elisabeth **Mueller** 23 Dec 1875 West Bend, Washington Co WI. Her father was Mathias Mueller. Her mother was Elizabeth [Mueller] [Techtmann], the second wife of Johann Christof Techtmann, page 9b-10.²⁰

John died 1 Jun 1928, age 85, at a sanitarium in Minneapolis, Hennepin Co MN, and was buried row 11, Union Cemetery, West Bend.² Born 9 Jun 1844 in WI, Elizabeth died 23 May 1932, age 87, at the home of son Henry A Techtmann, Milwaukee, Milwaukee Co WI, buried Evergreen Cemetery, Milwaukee.

1. Henry A³ **Techtmann** lived in Milwaukee WI.¹⁸ He married Minnie **Faust**; at least three children. Born 31 Jan 1877, Minnie died 10 Aug 1936, age 59.

a. Wilbur⁴ **Techtmann** was born about 1905.

b. Walter⁴ **Techtmann** was born about 1907.

c. Herbert⁴ **Techtmann** was born about 1914.

2. John Mathias³ **Techtmann**, born 11 Sep 1877, moved to Pueblo CO in his late teens, and to Portland OR in the early 1920s. He married (--?--) [Techtmann]; two children. Secondly, he married Theresa **Kenucane**; four children. She died 29 Jun 1963. He died 4 Dec 1965, age 88.²²

a. Mabel⁴ **Techtmann**, born 21 Mar 1901 in WI, buried Portland, Multomah Co OR.

b. Ellen⁴ **Techtmann**, born 19 Nov 1903 in WI, died 4 Dec 1999, age 96, buried Portland.

c. Jerome Joseph⁴ **Techtmann**, born 1 Jul 1913 in WI, buried Portland.

d. Aloysia Mary⁴ **Techtmann** was born 9 Nov 1915 in WI.

e. Eulalia⁴ **Techtmann** was born 26 Mar 1918.

f. Rosemary⁴ **Techtmann**, born 21 Jun 1920 Pueblo CO, married; one son. She died 6 Sep 1997 Arroyo Grande, San Luis Obispo CA, age 77, buried Arroyo Grande Cemetery, Arroyo Grande.²²

We appreciate the help her son has given us in providing information about his grandparents' family.

3. William³ **Techtmann** lived Corona CA.¹⁸

4. Frank³ **Techtmann** lived Chicago IL.¹⁸

5. Herman P³ **Techtmann**, born 12 Dec 1881, married Emilie **Boettcher** 6 Jun 1911. They lived West Bend WI. He died 29 Jul 1970, age 88. Born about 1882, she died 10 Jun 1971,¹⁸ age abt 89. They were buried Union Cemetery, West Bend, close beside their infant son Herman (1912-1913).

6. Joseph I³ **Techtmann** was born 24 Jan 1885 Barton, Washington Co WI. He died 21 Jun 1919 Milwaukee, Milwaukee Co WI, age 34,¹⁸ buried Evergreen Cemetery, Milwaukee.

F. Caroline Marie Amalie² “Mary” **Keil** was born 24 Feb 1865 Scott Township, Sheboygan Co WI.^{1,8} She was baptized 7 Mar/May 1865. Her sponsors were Ernst Gersmehl, Amalie Goldammer, and Juliane Graeser).¹⁵

She married Charles **Techtman** 1 Oct 1885 St John's Lutheran Church, West Bend WI;^{20,21} eight children born Barton Twp, Washington Co WI. His parents were Heinrich “Henrick” Techtmann and Minna **Guhl**.

Charles was born 5 Feb 1859 South Milwaukee WI. When he was three, his parents moved to Vernon, Waukesha Co WI. Charles changed the spelling of his surname from Techtmann to Techtman. In 1885 he came to Barton Twp and bought the farm of his parents-in-law, page 9b-2.

He died 11 Nov 1918 from cancer of the rectum, age 59.¹⁸ Mary died 17 Mar 1950, age 85, survived by two sisters, six children, 18 grandchildren, and 15 great-grandchildren. She and Charles were buried Union Cemetery, West Bend.

2. Ella³ **Techtman**, born 26 Dec 1887, married Frederick **Meinhardt** Feb 1919. They lived Kewaskum WI. She died 23 Aug 1983, West Bend WI, age 96,¹⁸ buried St John's UCC Cemetery, Kohlsville, Washington Co WI.

Two children: a daughter and a son.

3. Charles³ **Techtman**, born 18 Dec 1889, married Anna **Armstrong**. In 1950 they were living Maywood IL, a suburb of Chicago. (KFE and BFE's daughter and her family now (2006) live in Maywood.) Charles and Anna later went to Florida.¹⁸ Charles died 9 Jan 1980 Miami Shores, Dade Co FL, age 89.⁽²¹⁾ Born 7 Apr 1895, Anna died Nov 1980 Dade Co, age 85.

Two children: a daughter born 1925 Barton, and a son born 1926 Chicago.

Charles and several other people operated a cheese factory in a large frame building at 2996 Woodford Drive, Young America, Washington Co WI, near Barton. A thousand pounds or more of milk were processed each day. Cheese manufacturing stopped in 1930 and the building was sold to the town of Barton for use as its town hall. The building was the subject of an article in the West Bend News in the fall of 1999, and we have a copy.²⁰

4. Isabelle³ **Techtman**, born 14 Jun 1891/1892, married Oscar **Quast** 22 Mar 1920; one child. She died 10 Feb 1937 St Joseph's Hospital, Milwaukee WI of complications after a hysterectomy, age 45,^{18, 20} buried Wanderers Rest Cemetery, Milwaukee, between Oscar's first and third wives.

One child: a daughter.

5. Roxanne C³ "Roxana" **Techtman**, born 24 Oct 1896, lived Madison WI but never married. She died 15 Jan 1988 Milwaukee Co WI, age 91, buried beside her parents in Union Cemetery, West Bend WI.¹⁶

6. Edwin C³ **Techtman**, born 1 Jan 1901 Barton Township, Washington Co WI, married Martha Julia **Abel** 30 Apr 1927 St John's Lutheran Church, West Bend WI; three children. Her parents were John Abel and Emma **Heiser**. Edwin died 20 Feb 1984, age 83. Born 8 Nov 1908, Martha died 28 Jan 1987, age 78.^{18,20} They were buried Washington Co Memorial Park, West Bend.

a. a daughter.⁴ She was born 1927. She married Walter P **Wiedmeyer** 10 Jul 1948. His parents were George Wiedmeyer and Mary **Spanheimer**. Born 16 Jun 1918, Walter died 1996, age about 78.

i. a daughter.⁴ She has corresponded with us about family history, and has been most kind in sharing results of her research.²⁰

b. a daughter.⁴ She and her husband were both teachers in Wisconsin Synod parochial schools in Wrightstown WI.

c. a son.⁴ He married Doris May **Keller** 1960 St Lucas Lutheran Church, Kewaskum; two daughters. Her parents were Sylvester Keller and Clara **Neuy**. Doris was a library aide 26 years for the West Bend school district. Born 30 April 1931, she died 10 Jun 1993, age 62.

We were pleased to meet Mr Techtman on our June 2003 visit.

7. Barnas³ "Barney" **Techtman**, born 17 Mar 1904, married Florence **Brown** 30 Sep 1967; children not known to us. They lived Fountain City, Buffalo Co WI.¹⁸ He died 18 May 1987 Winona, Winona Co MN, age 83, buried Fountain City Cemetery, Fountain City.

8. Mae Ann³ **Techtman**, born 22 Jun 1906, married Milton **Deckow**; no children. They were divorced, and his name does not appear on her tombstone.

She was the first female employee of District 9 Regional Office of the US Dept of Agriculture Forestry Service, starting 25 Mar 1929.

She died 9 Jan 1992, Friendship Village, Milwaukee WI, age 85, buried beside her parents Union Cemetery, West Bend WI.¹⁶

I. Heinrich **Abel**, born about 1805-1808 Mecklenburg-Schwerin, married Maria [Abel]; eight children born Mecklenburg-Schwerin. She was born about 1809 Mecklenburg-Schwerin. They and their children immigrated to Barton, Washington Co WI on the *Hammonia*, arriving 16 Sep 1857 at Castle Garden NY.²⁸

Hammonia is Latin for Hamburg, presumably the ship's home port.

Although the Abel family is collateral to us, we'd like to know more about them. Why did they emigrate from Mecklenburg? They bought a farm not long after their arrival in Wisconsin, so they must have been well off financially. The present-day Abel Dairy Farms, well-known in Eden WI, were founded by some of their descendants.

A. Maria "Marie" **Abel**, born 20 Mar 1830, married Johan Heinrich "Henry" **Techtman**.
Two of their sons married daughters of Carl Gottlieb **Keil** -- [see page 9b-10](#).

B. Henrich "Henry" **Abel**, born about 1833, married Fredericke **Hendke** (born Pommern); three children: Henry (below), Emma (about 1866), and Henry (about 1872). In 1870 they were on their farm in Barton Twp, which was still in the family after 1900. From 1876-1885 Carl Gottlieb Keil's family lived nearby.

1. John W **Abel**, born about 1864, married Emma **Heiser**; eleven children born over 27 years:

a. Edwin John **Abel**, born 23 Aug 1892, married Olinda **Kibble**.

b. John Henry **Abel**, born 11 Aug 1895, married Esther **Benike**. He died 1963, age about 68.

G. Bertha Mathilde² **Keil**, born 21 Oct 1866 Scott Township, Sheboygan Co WI,⁸ was baptized 28 Oct 1866. Her sponsors were Johanna Stolper, Caroline Riedel, and Ernst Gersmehl.¹⁵

Bertha married Johann Franz Adam "John" **Techtmann** 6 Dec 1891 West Bend, Washington Co WI; four children born Washington Co. His parents were Johan Heinrich "Henry" Techtmann and Marie **Abel**, pages 9b-10 and 9b-15.

Born 3 Apr 1868 Barton Twp, Washington Co, John died 11 Oct 1955 Washington Co, age 87. Bertha died 27 Oct 1958 Washington Co, age 92. They were buried Union Cemetery, West Bend.²

THEIR FARM -- On our May 1999 trip to Wisconsin, our cousins took us to visit Bertha and John's farm. (Originally 80 acres, they later sold the farm to their older son, except for an acre-plus on the northeast corner, which they sold to their younger son).

It was good to see where the family had lived for so long. They had a fine brick home, a huge barn, an orchard, beehives, a large garden, and barn and field space for cattle, chickens, and other animals.

The woodshed had space for storing wood, but was a sophisticated building. Under the same roof were a smokehouse section and also a two-hole privy (which one entered through an outside door, so an onlooker would think one was just going into the shed). The woodshed also contained a big black kettle to cook meat when butchering, and had a workbench for making repairs, sharpening saws and scythes, etc.

In early years, a summer kitchen was used for all the cooking, canning and other work that went on in hot weather. The children remember when the thresher crews came and all the neighbors who helped were fed at noon and supertime. We could easily imagine the busy but happy life the family must have had there.

H. Auguste Emilie² **Keil**, usually called Emilie (pronounced as if spelled "Amelia"), was born 14 Nov 1868 Scott Township, Sheboygan Co WI.⁸ She was baptized 6 Dec 1868. Her sponsors were Johanna Stolper, Dora Seider, and Ernst Garschmahl.¹⁵

Emilie married Johann Paul Gerhardt **Buelow** (pronounced "Bee-lo"), 26 Oct 1889 St John Evangelical Lutheran Church, Wrightstown, Brown Co WI;^{3,5} three children born Kaukauna, Outagamie Co WI. His parents were Leopold Buelow and Fredericke H **Winne** (1825-1886).

In 1900 Emilie's mother, Christiane Hiller [Keil], was living with Emilie and Paul.

Born 1865, Paul died 1942, age about 77. Emilie died 1962 Kaukauna, age 94. They were buried Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Cemetery, Kaukauna.²

1. Paul E³ **Buelow**, born 24 Sep 1890 Kaukauna, married Ruth I **Hicks**. He served in WWI as Sergeant, Hq Co 55th Infantry. He died 5 Oct 1931 Outagamie Co, age 41, buried Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Cemetery, Kaukauna.²

a. a son⁷ was born 1925.

In 1986, he was living in Colorado. Unfortunately, there has been no response to a letter sent in 1989 to the address remembered by his cousin Mildred Keil Olsen.

2. Martha A³ **Buelow** was born 7 May 1892 Kaukauna. Never married, she was a school teacher, and later worked at AAL (Aid Association for Lutherans) in Appleton WI. She died 23 Feb 1966 Kaukauna, age 73, buried Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Cemetery, Kaukauna.²

One of our cousins recalls that Martha, her sister Rosetta, and their mother used to visit her (our cousin's) parents' family and other relatives in the area. The children loved it when they came, because they gave up their room to the visitors and were allowed to sleep on quilts on the floor in the upstairs hallway.⁹ The visitors had a little dog, and always brought candy.

3. Rosetta C³ **Buelow** was born 3 Oct 1896 Kaukauna. Never married, she worked at AAL (Aid Association for Lutherans) in Appleton WI. She died 3 Oct 1986 Kaukauna, age 90, buried Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Cemetery, Kaukauna.²

I. Charles Richard² Keil, called C R as an adult, was called Dick by his sisters' families (their children remember him as Uncle Dick). He was born 24 May 1874 Scott Township, Sheboygan Co WI,^{1,2} and was baptized 3 Jun 1874. His sponsors were Moritz Mueller, Caroline Groeser, and Helena Hubrich.¹⁵

He married Wilhelmina A "Minnie" Zellmer 24 Oct 1905 Winneconne, Winnebago Co WI; two children born Elgin, Kane Co IL. Her parents were Albert A Zellmer and Emilie Gustie Klug. C R and Minnie were known to their Edler grandchildren as "O'ma and O'pa Keil".

C R was a watchmaker and jeweller. He died 24 Dec 1944 Chicago, Cook Co IL, age 70, of a heart attack, buried 28 Dec 1944 Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Cemetery,² on Route 96 just east of Kaukauna, Outagamie Co WI, with his parents and the family of his sister, Augusta Emilie Keil Buelow.

Born 29 Feb 1884 Wolf River, Winnebago Co WI, Minnie died 1966 Elgin, age 82, buried Bluff City Cemetery, Elgin.^{2,12}

With the marriage of **Charles Richard Keil** and **Wilhelmina A Zellmer**

Based on the church records, we think Charles was christened Carl, but no one in the family remembers him having that name. (Or, whoever entered the information into the church records may have inadvertently recorded him as Carl because that would have been most frequently used in the community.)

In 1900 the census shows C R living alone in Winneconne, Winnebago Co WI. He worked in Neena or Menasha before going to Elgin IL to learn the watch trade. After he married Minnie Zellmer in 1905, they moved to Elgin where he worked for the Elgin Watch Company for over 30 years. In the latter part of his career, he was responsible for inspecting and making final adjustments on watches before they were shipped.¹²

FAMILY LIFE -- KFE remembers hearing about the next-door neighbors, Hazelbelle **Perry** and her mother, who were almost like kin and with whom his mother, Pearl Keil Edler, maintained a long relationship.

Their daughters recalled that C R and Minnie didn't get on well. The girls often listened at the top of the stairs to heated arguments that always started after they were put to bed. About 1933, shortly after his retirement from the watch company, the couple separated. Minnie got the house, at 611 St Charles Street, Elgin, and their daughters felt C R got the worst part of the agreement.

C R's LATER YEARS -- He returned to West Bend where he roomed with local families and operated a small watch and jewelry shop in the West Bend Theater building. He also sold popcorn and candy to the moviegoers. The last ten years of his life were spent there near the families of several of his sisters. In 1989 we visited West Bend and found the old theatre building, now in a restored "old town" section of the city.

In 1999 one of our cousins told us about her family's house where her Uncle Dick had a room when she was a girl, and other cousins drove us by the good looking brick house.

C R collapsed and died of a heart attack at age 70 on 24 Dec 1944 (KFE clearly remembers the phone call and his mother's grief on that Christmas Eve). It happened in a Chicago train or bus station on his way to visit KFE's aunt Mildred Olsen and her family in Des Moines IA. C R's family gifts and even his wristwatch disappeared, taken either by his discoverers or by the officials in Chicago.

MINNIE's LATER YEARS -- We don't know any details of how she lived after her separation from C R.

KFE remembers occasional visits back and forth between his family and Minnie. He relates how, when she would be leaving after a visit, one of his parents would distract her while the other one went through her luggage and retrieved various small items belonging to the family.

Minnie made the Edlers several lovely quilts including "Sunbonnet Sue". KFE remembers with special fondness one she made for him with butterflies on it. This appeals to BFE, because she is also a quilter. One of our prized possessions is a lovely hand stitched quilt with baskets in pale yellow (probably much faded) and white. Neither we nor KFE's sister Elizabeth Edler Wald know who made it, except that it came from the Keil side of the family, but we like to think it was Minnie's.

She apparently openly favored her firstborn grandson, KFE, somewhat to his embarrassment. He remembers going to see her mother Emilie Klug Zellmer, when he was a child and she was a very old lady.

1. Pearl Elizabeth³ Keil, born 6 Jan 1907,¹⁰ was a Registered Nurse.¹¹

She married Karl Friedrich Wilhelm Edler 31 Mar 1931 Baltimore, Baltimore City MD; two children: Karl Frederick Edler Jr (KFE) and Elizabeth Savilla Edler.

Karl's parents were August Friedrich Wilhelm Edler and Edmonia Wallach. Born 1 Oct 1905 Washington DC, Karl died 11 Jul 1972 San Diego CA, age 67.

Pearl died 7 Apr 1974 Grand Valley Hospital, Pryor, Mayes Co OK, age 67, of a heart attack while on a cross-country trip from California to Virginia.

2. William Henry³ **Techtman**, born 20 Sep 1892⁹ West Bend, Washington Co WI, was a member of St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, West Bend. He married Esther M **Landvatter** (pronounced "Lahnd-fah-ter") 2 Jun 1916 Methodist Church, Barton Twp, Washington Co WI, four children born Barton Twp.⁷ Her parents were Elias Landvatter and Lydia **Blaeser**.

Born 28 Jun 1895, Route 3, West Bend, Esther died 13 Aug 1975, St Joseph Community Hospital, West Bend, age 80. William died 8 Feb 1978 Cedar Lake Home, West Bend, age 86. They were buried Union Cemetery, West Bend.

They lived on his parents' farm in Barton Twp until 1939, when they moved to Kewaskum, where Esther was a member of the St Lucas Lutheran Ladies Aid Society. In 1957 they moved to West Bend.

In his memoirs, their son wrote about his parents.⁷ He said that, while William and Esther were farming, they used mostly horses for power, but in 1929 bought a Fordson tractor. They raised dairy cattle and hogs, and for cash crops they also raised barley for grain, red clover seed, and peas for the canning company at West Bend.

They went through some hard times like most farmers in those years. During some of those years potatoes were a "drug on the market. I could buy all the potatoes I could load on for \$1.50 a load. I had a Ford 1.5 ton truck with a special device called a ruxel" [defined as a worm-drive axle] "that gave it more power, so I could haul 1.5 ton. We would boil the potatoes along with pumpkins, put in a barrel along with middlings" [defined as a by-product of grain milling], "mix it up and use that along with milk whey to feed the pigs. Later they were fed cob corn to top them off. A dressed 200# pork brought \$8 or \$9 delivered."

They dressed as many as 30 hogs a year and sold them to people in West Bend for a dollar more than the market price. The dollar was for butchering them and hauling them to town. "Neighbors worked back and forth helping each other butcher and also with other farm work where two or more could work better than one." During the lean years, barley and rye were roasted together instead of coffee.⁷

A. Elias **Landvatter** Jr, born 23 Nov 1857 Route 3, West Bend, Washington Co WI, married Lydia **Blaeser**; eleven children born Route 3, West Bend. He was a farm owner and investor. Lydia's parents were William Blaesser Sr and Barbara **Uebele**. Elias died 14 Nov 1934, age almost 76. Born 16 Jul 1863 West Bend, Lydia died about 1944, age about 81. They were buried Kopp Cemetery.

THE BLAESER FAMILY -- William Blaesser Sr, born about 1827 Esselborn, Darmstadt, Germany, married Barbara **Uebele**, who was born 1827 Pfahlbronn, Germany. Her parents were Johann Georg Uebele and Marie **Koppenhöfer**.

William and Barbara had seven children in Wisconsin: Louisa, William Jr, Lena, Lydia, Mary, Katherine, and Charles. Barbara died 1908, age about 81. William Sr died 1915, age about 88.

2. Katie **Landvatter**, born 1889, married Walter M **Rilling** 1912, lived West Bend; one daughter.

2. Alvina A³ **Techtman**, born 10 Jun 1895 Washington Co WI, married Theodore E **Wornardt** 11 Apr 1917 West Bend, Washington Co; three children. His parents were Gustave and Anna Wornardt. Alvina (pronounced "Al-vine-a") died 4 Jan 1976, age 80. Born 15 July 1896, Theodore died 3 Dec 1979, age 83. They were buried Washington County Memorial Park, West Bend.

Theodore's sister Clara was the mother of James J Rauen, page 9b-24.

a. John T⁴ **Wornardt**, born 17 Mar 1918, married Helen M **Naumann** 12 Jun 1937; one child. He died 13 Oct 1978, age 60. Born 5 Jul 1918, she died 20 Jan 1999, age 80. They were buried Holy Angels Cemetery, West Bend WI.

i. a son,⁵ born 1945, married 1968; two children (as of 2003, both were married).

b. Rose Bertha⁴ **Wornardt** was born 1922. She married Thomas D **Slagenhoup** 1946; one son, who married and has two children. Born 12 May 1918, Thomas died 7 Oct 2005, age 87. She died 20 Feb 2009, age about 87.

She wasn't able to come to the family gathering on our May 1999 trip to Wisconsin, but she sent a beautiful Swiss ladies' watch for KFE. It had been given to her on her sixteenth birthday by KFE's grandfather Charles Richard Keil, page 9b-18. She had helped him in his shop, and remembers her Uncle Dick with fondness.

Since she doesn't have a daughter, she thought KFE would be the best person to have it. He is, of course, extremely pleased by her thoughtfulness and by the very nice memento of his O'pa.

c. Roy Richard Paul⁴ **Wornardt**, born 25 Aug 1926, married 4 Jul 1948 Caledonia MN. He died 9 Apr 1994, age 66.

We were so pleased to meet Roy's widow in June 2003. She provided some updated information about her children and grandchildren.

ii. Diane Lynn⁵ **Wornardt** was born 19 Apr 1953. She had cystic fibrosis, and died 21 Dec 1972, age 19, buried Washington County Memorial Park, West Bend WI.

iii. a daughter,⁵ born 1958, married 1980; no children. They were divorced. She married 1986; two children. In 2003 they were living West Bend WI.

4. Richard John Clarence³ **Techtman** was born 27 Oct 1905 Washington Co WI. He married Frieda Johanna Anna **Hagner** 2 Sep 1931 Fillmore, Washington Co;¹⁴ six children born West Bend, Washington Co. Her parents were Charles Hagner (1869-1955) and Katherine **Petri** (1870-1949). Richard died 31 May 1976, age 70,⁹ St Joseph's Community Hospital, buried Union Cemetery, West Bend, near Frieda's parents. Born 29 Jan 1903, Frieda died 31 Aug 2005, age 102, buried Union Cemetery.

Richard bought his parents' farm from his father, and he and Frieda raised their children there. They farmed until 1974 when they moved to 525 No 18th Ave, West Bend.

Meeting Frieda was a special delight at the family gathering her children held for us when we visited in May 1999. She was 96 and the last of her generation of the Techtman/Keil families. She was frail and couldn't take part very much, but said she was enjoying "watching" and didn't want to leave too early. Later we saw the nursing home, in an attractive old house in West Bend, where she had a first floor front corner room.

Based on naming patterns we've seen, we've wondered if her name might originally have been Johanna Elfriede Anna.

a. a son,⁴ born 1932, married 1974 West Bend; no children.⁹

He was stationed at Ft Belvoir VA about 1951. He visited KFE's parents at least once while he was there, and we remember meeting him. It was great to see him again and meet his wife.

They live on his parents' farm, which is a blessing, enabling it to be kept in the family. Recently they've put a fine new roof on the large barn, such a contrast to the many collapsed barns we saw in the region. They rent out the actual farm and stay busy with their other activities.

He is retired, but keeps a commercial driver's license and is on the road a lot, delivering huge tractor-trailers all over the country. She is employed full-time in the Washington County Personnel Department.

She comes from a family of five children, three girls and two boys, whose great-grandparents immigrated from Poland. She enjoys the company of her nieces and nephews, some of whom live next door. At the 1999 family gathering, we were impressed with how sweet she was to her mother-in-law.

b. a daughter,⁴ born 1934, married 1956 West Bend; three children.⁹

She has provided much of the information we have on the descendants of the Techtman family. We had been corresponding with her for about ten years, and were so pleased to meet her and her family on our trip to Wisconsin in May 1999. And we enjoyed visiting with them again in 2003.

They have a condominium duplex in an attractive suburban area of West Bend, the very nicest we've seen for enjoying retirement living. We were impressed with how beautifully the house and yard are kept, and especially enjoyed seeing his woodworking shop in the basement.

She worked at Schloemer Law Office for 30 years before working at the Register of Deeds Office in the Washington Co courthouse on So 5th Ave, a wonderful old building which some of the children think looks like a castle. In the yard of the courthouse is a large statue "Spirit of the American Doughboy". (BFE's dad liked the original of the statue so much that he bought a small reproduction of it, made into a table lamp which we still have.) Before she retired, she worked at the new Washington Co courthouse on E Washington St.

Her husband worked with data systems at the West Bend Company, which produces a wide variety of home appliances and other things. He retired after more than 40 years of service.

i. a daughter,⁵ born 1957, married 1981; two daughters. In 2003 she was General Manager at the West Bend Co, and her husband was with computers at M&I Data Services.

ii. a son,⁵ born 1960, married 1982; one son.

iii. a son,⁵ born 1964, was a set designer in 1999, unmarried, living in Portland OR. He has a master's degree in theatre, and has worked at the Shakespeare Festival in Ashland OR, at Portland Center Stage, and at Will Vinton animation studio on Fox TV commercials and programming.

c. a daughter,⁴ born 1937, married 1959 West Bend; four children. Her husband retired 1999 from the West Bend Company after over 40 years as an electrical equipment specialist.

We enjoyed meeting them at the family gathering on our 1999 visit. She has helped us with this project, and we've corresponding back and forth via e-mail. And, the June 2003 family gathering at their house in Kewaskum was a great pleasure!

i. a son,⁵ born 1962, married 2001 Midland MI.

ii. a daughter,⁵ born 1963, married 1987; three children. She is a teacher.

iii. a daughter,⁵ born 1964, married 1991 Waukesha WI; four children. Her husband is a pastor. She is a quilter, and it was especially nice to see some of her quilts in June 2003.

iv. a daughter,⁵ born 1973, married 1995; two children.

d. a daughter,⁴ born 1938, married 1960 West Bend; four children.

Formerly an accountant with the Washington County Sheriff's Department, she retired Apr 2001. Her husband retired from Gehl Co in 2002.

i. a daughter,⁵ born 1960 West Bend, married 1986 Chicago IL; two children born Oak Lawn IL.

ii. a son,⁵ born 1961 West Bend, married 1986; three children. Their older son and their daughter were born Appleton WI. Their younger son was born Green Bay WI.

iii. a daughter,⁵ born 1962 Tacoma, Pierce Co WA, married 1991; one daughter born West Bend.

iv. a son,⁵ born 1965 Fond du Lac, Fond du Lac Co WI, married 1992 Fond du Lac; two children born West Bend. The younger child, Alex Robert, was born 26 Sep 1996. He died 24 Feb 1999 West Bend, age 2½.

e. a son,⁴ born 1944 West Bend, married 1971 Milwaukee WI.

Three children: a daughter born 1980, a daughter born 1983, and a son born 1990.

They bought one-plus acres of his parents' (and formerly grandparents') farm, and built a house there. He works at Johnson Controls in Milwaukee, about a 45-minute commute, and we think this is neat to be able to work in the city but live in the country. It was so nice to meet them and their children at the family gathering. His wife's great-grandparents immigrated to America from Poland.

f. a daughter,⁴ born 1946, married 1973 Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, West Bend.

Two children born Menomonee Falls, Waukesha Co WI: a daughter born 1974 and a son born 1977.

We enjoyed meeting them and their son at the family gathering. Her husband is retired from trucking, and she works in new home sales. They live on his parents' farm. His family came to America from Vilshofen, Germany.

2. Mildred Lucile³ "Millie" **Keil**, born 30 Mar 1908 Elgin, Kane Co IL, married Kai Theodore **Olsen** 10 Jun 1933 Ames, Story Co IA; four children, two of whom were adopted. They lived most of their married life in Menomonee, Dunn Co WI. She was an instructor in English,¹² and he was an instructor in home construction, at the University of Wisconsin - Stout.

Kay (as his name was usually spelled) was born 1905 in Denmark. His parents were Lars Olsen and Laura **Peterson**. When he was 8 or 9 years old, Kay and his father immigrated to America following the death of his mother in 1912, and lived near Battle Creek IA. He died 1985, age about 80, buried Evergreen Cemetery, Menomonie, Dunn Co WI.^{2,12} Millie died 13 Jul 2002, age 94, buried next to her husband.

We visited Millie and Kay in Menominee about 1953, and especially enjoyed seeing the products of Kay's excellent woodworking skills. On another trip to Menominee in May 1989, we visited Millie in an apartment she and Kay had selected before he died. She was living alone, enjoying social and other activities in the university town as well as occasional Elderhostel seminars with friends. We really enjoyed that visit with her.

During a Christmas visit with her daughter in 1991, Millie became ill with flu and pneumonia and had several falls resulting in brain damage from clots. She went to the Dunn Co WI Health Care Center in spring 1992, and later was transferred to another facility. Sadly, she became increasingly confused and dependent, and by 1998 did not recognise family members. Her younger daughter lived nearby nearby and visited her often.

a. Dennis Richard⁴ **Olsen**, born 2 Feb 1935, married Kathleen **Wahl** -- see page 9b-31.

b. a daughter,⁴ born 1939 Des Moines, Polk Co IA, married 1963 Menomonie.

A PhD, she retired as an Associate Professor (Extension) at Iowa State University. Fortunately, we've gotten together with her several times.

THEIR FAMILY -- In addition to their own two daughters, they adopted the four children of her brother Dennis, after he and his wife were killed in an automobile accident, page 9b-31. The children's surname was not changed.

i. a daughter,⁵ born 1966 Atlantic, Cass Co IA, married 1988 in PA. They were divorced 1990. She married 1991 Des Moines, Polk Co IA. They were divorced before Jan 1997. She married again.¹⁴ In 1998, she was teaching full time at a veterinary college in St Paul MN, and she and her husband had a nice home in the woods east of the city. Their daughter was born Mar 2002.

ii. a daughter,⁵ born 1969 Minneapolis, Hennepin Co MN, received a Master of Science degree in Public Policy from the University of Minnesota 1997. She married 1997 in an outdoor candlelight service. As of 1998, they have a duplex house. Their son was born Mar 1999.

c. a son,⁴ born about 1950 Menomonie, was adopted by Kay and Millie Olsen following a period as foster parents. As of 1999, he communicates with his sister occasionally.¹²

d. a daughter,⁴ born about 1950 Menomonie, was adopted by Kay and Millie Olsen following a period as foster parents. She married, and in 1999 was living and working about 30 miles away from Millie and visiting her regularly.

HARVEY WILLIAM TECHTMAN (b 1917) and his descendants

a. Harvey William⁴ **Techtman**, born 9 Jul 1917 Barton, Washington Co WI, married 9 Apr 1944; five children, all except the first born in Fond du Lac, Fond du Lac Co WI.

He attended high school at West Bend and drove there in a Model T Ford. After graduation he became a mortician and a successful funeral director, first at Kewaskum. Then, after service in WWII, he opened a funeral home at Hilbert WI. Later he purchased the Kapfer-Gehl Funeral Home in Barton. With his partner, Ole Myrhum, they built a beautiful funeral home (Techtman-Myrhum) on Highway 33 west of West Bend. It is now (1999) Myrhum-Patton.

We were so pleased to meet Harvey's widow in June 2003, when we attended a family gathering in Kewaskum WI.

Harvey's birth certificate spelled his last name with only one "n", and he kept it that way.

KFE recalls a brief visit with his parents to the Harvey Techtman family in West Bend when he was a child. His memory is of a large and comfortable home and an active family. He had never, before or since, met anyone who had a funeral home, and was quite impressed.

There is a family story that Harvey's father didn't want his son to be thought of as a "dumb farmer". He felt that a funeral home for Lutherans would be profitable in Washington Co, so he obtained an apprenticeship to an undertaker for Harvey. In those days, fathers often had a bit to say about their children's life work.

i. a daughter,⁵ born 1946 West Bend, Washington Co WI, married 1967 St John's Church, West Bend; two sons. In 1999 they were living Ripon WI, where she was an art teacher.

ii. a son,⁵ born 1950, married 1972; one son. They divorced, and the son was adopted by his mother's second husband.

Secondly, he married 1976; three children. They divorced.

iii. a son,⁵ born 1951, married 1972 in AZ; two children. They divorced 1978.

iv. a daughter,⁵ born 1956, married 1984 Hubertus, Washington Co. She is a dental hygienist and her husband is a dentist.

v. Carl John⁵ **Techtman** was born 30 Dec 1957. He graduated from St John's Lutheran School in West Bend, and from West Bend East High School 1976. He lived at 606 Spring Drive, West Bend, and was a welder, employed by Luedtke Mfg Co. He died 1 Dec 1978 West Bend, Washington Co WI, age almost 21, in a motor accident on Rt 41 south of Rt 33, buried Union Cemetery, West Bend.

b. Louise Matilda⁴ **Techtmann** was born 22 Jul 1919 Barton Township, Washington Co WI.⁷ She attended State Teacher's College in Milwaukee and Dodge County Normal School, graduating in 1939.

She married Harvey **Dhein** 27 Jun 1942 St Lucas Lutheran Church, Kewaskum WI; three children. His parents were Peter Jacob Dhein and Caroline **Henrich**.

Born 11 Jun 1918, Harvey died 22 Jun 2004, age 86. Louise died 12 Mar 2006, age 86, and was buried Christ Church Cemetery, Dheinsville (Germantown).³⁰

Louise first taught at Golden Oak School, District #4, Town of Barton. (The old stone building, still standing in 1999, later became the Good Luck 4-H clubhouse.) She also taught at several other schools before her marriage. Harvey was also a teacher, and later became the manager of the Consumer's Coop of West Bend.

We enjoyed meeting them on our May 1999 Wisconsin trip, and learning that they had a family, which we hadn't known before. Harvey mentioned a very unusual item about his siblings -- four of his sisters married four **Schwalter** brothers. Also, three of his parents' grandchildren became United Church of Christ ministers.

i. a son,⁵ born 1944, married Lisbeth "Beth" **Lauer** 1965; two children. Born 28 Oct 1946, she died 22 Dec 1979, age 33, in an automobile accident caused by a 16-year old drunk driver.

He later married again, and in 1999 he and his wife were living Hartford WI.

ii. a son,⁵ born 1947, married 1970; three children.

iii. a daughter,⁵ born 1950, married 1974; two children.

-- Some information about another KEIL family --

In 1900 and 1910, a Keil family was living in Kaukauna, Outagamie Co WI, a few doors away from the family of Louisa Ottilie Christiane Keil and Carl Staniske, page 9b-32, and the family of Auguste Emilie Keil and Johann Paul Gerhardt Buelow, page 9b-17. The relationship, if any, of this Keil family to our other Keil families is unknown. We are including the information here for possible use by a future researcher.

August Keil, born Dec 1832 in "Germany"

Minnie, wife, born Dec 1855 in "Germany"

Carl A, son, born Oct 1885 in "Germany"

Emil, son, born July 1893 in Wisconsin

Herman, son, born Sep 1896 in Wisconsin (died Feb 1979 in Wisconsin, age about 82)

We have wondered if August could possibly be a son of a first (unknown to us) marriage of Johann Carl Gottlieb Keil, page 9b-1. According to the information we have, Carl was 42 years old when he married Johanna Christiane Hiller, so there would have been plenty of time for him to have had an earlier marriage we haven't known about. Or, August could have been a nephew or a cousin. Or, he may not be related to us at all. August and his family immigrated to America in 1892, 32 years after "our" Keils.

a. Dennis Richard⁴ “Denny” **Olsen**, born 2 Feb 1935 Des Moines, Polk Co IA, married Kathleen **Wahl** 21 Jun 1958; four children, one of whom was adopted. Born 1938, she was daughter of George E Wahl MD (1913-1989) and Kathryn Mattison (1916-2005) of Eau Claire WI.²⁹

Denny was a physician, having graduated from medical school in Madison WI and practiced in New Hampton IA.¹²

He and Kathleen met in school, and both enjoyed playing competitive bridge. As they returned home from a tournament, they were killed 6 May 1973 in an auto accident near Cedar Rapids, Linn Co IA, ages 38 and 35, by a 28 year-old drunk driver. They were buried Evergreen Cemetery, Menomonie, Dunn Co WI.²

Their children were later adopted by Denny's sister and her husband; the children's names weren't changed.

KFE recalls good times with Denny and his sister when his father and mother visited their family in Des Moines. He wished they lived closer so he would have cousins to play with all the time.

i. a daughter,⁵ born 1959 Madison, Dane Co WI, graduated from Iowa State College. She married 1981 Davenport, Scott Co IA; two daughters and one son.

ii. a son,⁵ born 1963 New Hampton, Chickasaw Co IA, graduated from the University of Osteopathic Medicine, Des Moines IA, 1989 and interned in Chicago at Northwestern University Hospital. As part of his studies, he spent some time in South Africa. In 1999 he was unmarried, loved to travel, and practicing in Denver CO.¹⁴

iii. a daughter,⁵ born 1965 New Hampton, Chickasaw Co IA, married 1984; two daughters and one son. In 1999 they were living Des Moines IA.

iv. a son⁵ was born 1969 Clinton, Clinton Co IA.¹⁴ His mother was a nurse, father not known. He was adopted by Dennis and Kathleen Olsen. He had trouble as a child with behavior problems. As an adult, he enjoys gardening and in 1997 had a water garden with a waterfall. He married; four daughters.

Lizzie married Carl "Charles" **Staniske** 8 Oct 1888 Reformed Church, Wrightstown, Brown Co WI,⁵ eight children. He was a stone mason. His parents were Wilhelm Staniske and Elizabeth [Staniske].

Born Sep 1855 in Germany, Charles died about 1933, age about 78. Lizzie died about 1936, age about 73. They were buried Union Cemetery, Kaukana, Outagamie Co WI.

In October 2006, we were surprised and pleased to hear from a descendent of Lizzie and Charles. She had seen her great-grandparents on our website and noticed that we had no picture of them, so she sent us their wedding photograph!

We had tried for a long time to find information about them. This was such a lovely thing for her to do -- now we have something about each of the siblings of KFE's grandfather!
