Georg's parents are not known to us
Anna Maria's parents were Peter Lober and Anna Catharina Leimbeck

Note: in various old documents Wallick was spelled Volk, Folk, Walck, Walch, Wallige or Walligh.

I. Georg¹ Wallick^{1,3} was christened 14 Oct 1754 Trinity Lutheran Church, New Holland PA. We don't know when he was born, possibly as much as two or three years before his christening.

He married Anna Maria Lober 25 Dec 1770 Lutheran Church, New Hanover, Philadelphia Co PA⁹ (later Montgomery Co PA); at least nine children. She was born 31 Aug 1752 New Hanover. Her parents were Peter Lober and Anna Catharina Leimbeck.

The third child of Georg and Anna Maria was born in PA in 1782, but the family moved to MD between then and the birth of the sixth child in 1790. Georg died in 1806 Washington Co MD, age probably at least 52. We don't know when Anna Maria died or where they were buried.

THE LOBER FAMILY -- Johan Jacob Lober and Margareta Friedrich were parents of Peter, born 22 Feb 1714 Württemberg. He married Anna Catharina Leimbeck about 1739. Born 5 Feb 1707/8, she died 21 Aug 1781, age about 73. He died about Jun 1789 Montgomery Co PA, age about 75.

PARENTS OF CHRISTIAN WALLICK SR -- Based on confirmation and other church records in Hagerstown, Washington Co MD, we believe that Georg and Maria Wallick were the parents of Christian Wallick Sr, shown on the following page as their first child. Christian and other children of "George Wallick" appeared on communicant records of St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown, between 1797 and 1803.⁴ Also, there is evidence that Christian served as co-executor (with his sister Mary) of their father Georg's estate in 1806/1807.¹

We haven't, however, been able to verify completely that the Georg Wallick and Anna Maria Lober shown above were Christian's parents. Although they were about the right age and in the right location, one curious item causes some uncertainty -- the gap of approximately seven years between the marriage of Georg and Anna Maria and the birth of their oldest child. After that, they had children every few years, sometimes only a year apart. It's true, unfortunately, that infants often died so young that no record was kept, so it's possible that they had several children during this period who didn't live.

Note: citing church records and a tombstone in New Hanover, another researcher believes Georg Wallick married a different daughter of Peter Lober and Anna Catherina Leimbeck -- Maria Barbara (born about 1744). That researcher also believes that the Lobers did have a daughter Anna Maria (1752-1814) but that in 1778 she married George **Seyfried**.

A possibility which has recently been raised is that Georg Wallick may have married twice -- that he married Maria Barbara after a divorce from Anna Maria. If this is what happened, it could clarify that Anna Maria's marriage to George Seyfried was her second marriage, and it could also explain why Georg Wallick's first child (whose mother was Maria Barbara) wasn't born until about 1777.

One reason that Anna Maria might be the mother of Georg Wallick's children is that Maria Barbara would have been about 53 years old when the youngest child was born, whereas Anna Maria was 45, a much more likely age.

It is, of course, possible that there were more than one Anna Maria Lober and more than one Georg Wallick in the area at the time. The only real conclusion one can derive from this interesting set of facts and assumptions is that the parentage of Christian Wallick Sr is somewhat of a mystery, one that we may never be able to resolve.

A. Christian² Wallick Sr^{3,5} was born about 1777, probably in PA (age stated as 18 at confirmation, St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown, Washington Co MD 19 Apr 1785).⁴

According to Ohio land records beginning in 1805, Christian applied for 160 acres in Fairfield Co OH, and made payments to the US Land Office.² He may have lived in Ohio for a while, perhaps returning several times to MD when he was co-administrator of Georg Wallick's estate in 1806/7.¹ By 1810 the records show the land transferred to his brother Conrad.

Christian married **Ann Harrison** 15 Nov 1814; two children. She was born about 1794. Her parents were **Nathan Harrison** and **Mary Badan**.

Christian died between 7 Jun 1816 (date of will) and 26 Jun 1816 (date of probate), age about 39. He bequeathed his estate to his "beloved wife Ann (then pregnant) and daughter Mary" (age nine months).⁶

Ann married **Jacob Miller** 10 Jul 1823; six children, Section 12a. She died about 1842, age about 48.

With the marriage of **Christian Wallick Sr** and **Ann Harrison**
our **WALLICK** lineage is joined by our **HARRISON** lineage
-- see [{Section 11b}](#) --

1. **Mary³ Wallick,⁶** born Sep 1815, apparently did not marry. The 1850 census of Montgomery Co MD shows her living with her brother Christian Jr. The 1880 census shows her, age 65, as an aunt of John W Wallick in his household, page 13-17.¹⁰ We've tried unsuccessfully to find more about Mary.

2. **Christian³ Wallich Jr,** born about 1816, married **Ariana Miller** -- see page 13-8.

B. George² Wallick was born about 1780, probably in PA. He was confirmed in 1798 (age stated as 18) St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown, Washington Co MD.⁴ He married Elizabeth **Spohn** 7 Feb 1811 Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church, Frederick, Frederick Co MD;⁵ no children known to us. He probably served in 1812 as a private in Cramer's detachment, Maryland Militia.⁵

C. Conrad² Wallick, born 28 Jul 1782 in PA, married **Katharina Bard** -- see page 13-5.

D. Barbara² Wallick, born about 1783, was confirmed in 1798 (age stated as 15) St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown.⁴

F. Elisabeth² Wallick, born 25 May 1785, was confirmed in 1806⁴ (age stated as 18) St John's.⁵ She married Wendel **Fasnacht** 3 May 1813 St John's; see note on next page. He was born 4 Dec 1784. His parents were Adam Fasnaucht Sr and Barbara Eve **Root**. Wendel died 24 Oct 1858 Fairfield Co OH, age 73. Elisabeth died 25 Mar 1867 Fairfield Co,⁵ age almost 82. They are said to have been buried Old Conrad Cemetery, Fairfield Co; not yet located by us.

Eleven children,⁵ all but the first born Fairfield Co: Jacob M 9 Mar 1812 Washington Co MD; Samuel Jul 1813; Catherine about 1814; Amy 3 Feb 1816; Wendell Jr 1820; Harrison 8 Nov 1822; William 15 Sep 1823; Barney about 1825; Matilda about 1827; Lavina 15 Sep 1828; and Martha Jane 22 Dec 1831.

F. Mary² "Polly" **Wallick**,¹ born about 1786, was confirmed in 1803 (age stated as 17) St John's. She was co-administrator of Georg Wallick's estate in 1806/7.

She married Henry **Lichty (Leighty?)** 10 Aug 1807 St John's;⁵ no children known to us.

G. Rosina² (Rosanna?) **Wallick**, born 19 Sep 1790 Washington Co MD, was confirmed in 1807 (age stated as 17)⁵ St John's.⁴ She married John (Johannes) **Fasnacht** 31 Aug 1812 St John's; no children known to us. See note below. His parents were Henry Fasnacht and Magdalena **Root**. Born about 1789 in MD, John died 11 June 1853 in MD, age about 61.

H. Matthias² **Wallick**, born 25 Mar 1795 Washington Co MD, married Nancy **Rohrer**

-- see page 13-7.

I. John² (Johannes) **Wallick**, born 4 Sep 1797 Washington Co MD, was christened 14 Nov 1797 St John's.⁴ He married Susanna **Fasnacht** 24 Aug 1821 in MD, probably Baltimore Co,^{14,25} at least three children. See note below. She was born 15 Jul 1797, daughter of Johann Conrad Fasnacht and Catherina **Acker**.

A farmer in Washington Co,¹⁴ John built a stone house on his farm north of Hagerstown when he married Susanna. It is now (2001) modernized and possibly functioning as a small apartment house, off Northern Avenue in the northern part of the city, behind the Longmeadow Shopping Center.

Susanna died 5 Feb 1879 Hagerstown, age 82. John died 6 May 1881 Hagerstown, age 83. They were buried Longmeadow Cemetery, Paramount, Washington Co.

1. Joseph³ **Wallick**, born 5 Mar 1822, married Mary Elizabeth **Troup** -- see page 13-15.

2. James³ **Wallick** was born about 1823.⁵

3. Mahala Susan³ **Wallick**, born 7 Jun 1838, married Jacob Baer **Lehman Jr** -- see page 13-16.

Note: Wendel (page 13-2), John, and Susanna Fasnacht were first cousins, grandchildren of Johannes Fasnacht.

This family is interesting to us for three reasons --

First, three Fasnacht first cousins married three Wallick siblings.

Second, the Fasnacht family came from Württemberg to Lancaster Co PA about the same time BFE's ancestors Johan and Magdalena Glück came from Lohrhaupten, Hesse, to Berks Co PA, near Lancaster Co, Section 5. Also, some of BFE's sister's husband's Redsecker family were in Lancaster Co from about 1737, Section 16.

Third, the Fasnachts relocated about 1773 to Fairfield Co OH, where many of BFE's Cole ancestors lived after 1801, Section 6b.

Caution: most information on the next page is from websites found on the Internet and has not been verified by us.

I. Samuel Fasnacht was born about 1677 "in Germany".

A. Samuel Fasnacht, born 10 Mar 1697/98 Hohengehren, Jagst, Württemberg, married Maria **Unrath** 3 Sep 1720. She was born about 1698. He died 26 Mar 1773 Hohengehren, age 76.

Seven children born Hohengehren: Maria 24 Nov 1717; Anna Maria 27 Apr 1721; Christian 25 Dec 1722; Sabina 24 Sep 1725; Johannes 26 Mar 1727; Jakob 8 Jul 1729; Christiana 13 Jan 1730/31.

1. Johannes Fasnacht, born 26 Mar 1727, came to Lancaster Co PA before 1751 and married Anna Konigunda **Heiser**. Born about 1725, she probably died before 1753, age probably about 28. Secondly, he married Juliana Margaretha **Adam**. She was born 3 Nov 1733 Lancaster Co PA. They moved to MD about 1773. He died Jun 1807 Washington Co MD, age 80. She died after 1810 Washington Co, age at least 77, buried Fahmey's Meeting House Cemetery, Lancaster Co PA.

First marriage, one son: Johan Conrad, born 9 Nov 1751.

Second marriage, nine children: first eight born Lancaster Co: Johanna Catarina 1754; Johann Jacob 1755; Anna Dorothea 1757; Adam Sr 1762; Susannah 1765; Anna Maria 1767; Henry 1768; Bernard 1771; and Jacob 1773 Washington Co MD.

a. Johan Conrad Fasnacht, born 9 Nov 1751 New Holland PA, married Catherina **Acker**. She was born 12 Mar 1754 New Holland. They remained in PA when his father and stepmother moved to MD. Johan Conrad died 13 Jun 1909 Lebanon Co, age 57.

Thirteen children, first three born New Holland, others born Lebanon Co PA: Elisabet 1775; Johannes 1776; Conrad 1778; Catharina 1780; Friedrich 1784; Lenert 1786; Elisabeth 1788; Lenert 1790; Anna Maria 1792; Eva and Rebecca 1794; Susanna 1797; and Sara 1798.

i. Susanna Fasnacht, born 15 Jul 1797, married John **Wallick** -- [see page 13-3](#).

b. Adam Fasnacht Sr, born about 1762 Cocalico Twp, Lancaster Co PA, married Barbara Eve **Root** about 1779 Fairfield Co OH. Born 15 May 1761, she died 16 Jan 1839, age 78. He died 8 Apr 1845 Clear Creek Twp, Fairfield Co, age about 83. They were buried Dutch Hollow Cemetery, Fairfield Co.

Ten children born Washington Co MD: Susannah H 1780; John 1781; Wendel 1784; Christian 1786; Barbara 1788; Jacob Root 1789; Adam Jr 1791; Catherine 1795; Bernard 1800; and Elizabeth 1801.

i. Wendel Fasnacht, born 20 Aug 1784, married Elisabeth **Wallick** -- [see page 13-2](#).

c. Henry Fasnacht, born about 1768 Lancaster Co PA, married Magdalena **Root**.

i. John Fasnacht, born about 1789, married Rosina **Wallick** -- [see page 13-3](#).

CONRAD WALLICK (b 1782) and KATHARINA BARD (b 1786) and their descendants from page 13-2

C. Conrad² **Wallick**, also known as Johann Conrad, was born 28 Jul 1782 in PA. He married Katharina **Bard** 2 Mar 1805 St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown, Washington Co MD;⁵ eleven children. She was born 21 Dec 1786 Hagerstown. Her parents were Zachariah and Maria Bard. All we know about the Bard family is that the German surname Bard translates as Beard.

Conrad was probably a farmer most of his life. He started his family in Washington Co MD but left for Ohio not later than about 1810, when title to some of his brother Christian's land, page 13-2, was transferred to him. Conrad must have travelled back and forth along the National Road several times during the next few years, possibly as a drover. About the same time he apparently began to style his name as **Walley**.

He evidently moved his family to Springfield Twp, Muskingum Co OH near Zanesville¹⁰⁴ by 1821, and then to Perry Twp, Franklin Co OH by 1829. They moved to Mill Creek Twp in Union Co OH by 1850, when at least three of their children (John, Samuel, and William) were in their household.

Finally, in their mid-70s, about 1859, he and his wife sold their Mill Creek farm to their youngest son, William, and went to Bates Co MO to live with their son George.¹⁰⁴

Conrad died 20 Jan 1860 Amsterdam, Bates Co MO, age 77. Katharina may have moved back to Mill Creek Twp (in the 1860 census she was listed in the household of her son Samuel, next door to son William, but she could possibly have been visiting). She died 11 Oct 1865 (or 1867), age 78 (or 80). She was buried beside Conrad in Walley Cemetery, 2½ miles northeast of Amsterdam.¹⁰⁴

1. Michael³ **Walley**, born 17 Dec 1805 Washington Co MD,⁴ was christened 3 Mar 1806 St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown, Washington Co. He married Flortella **Lattemes** in Oct 1830 Franklin Co OH;¹⁰³ no children known to us. In the 1870 census, he is shown as a farmer (age 67) in Washington Twp, Hancock Co OH, with his wife Tabitha (age 64, born in OH). We don't know anything else about them.
2. Zachariah³ **Walley**, born 1 Nov 1807, married Catherine Ann **Cryder** and married Eunice Louisa **Warren** -- [see page 13-9](#).
3. George Alvin³ **Walley**, born 30 Sep 1810, married Elizabeth **Thomas** -- [see page 13-12](#).
4. Mary³ **Walley**, born 17 Oct 1812 Washington Co MD,¹⁰³ married John **Dick** 2 Nov 1837 Franklin Co OH; no children known to us. Born about 1801 in PA, he died 1860 Bates Co MO, age 59.
5. Catherine³ **Walley** was born 21 May 1814 Washington Co MD.
6. John³ **Walley**, born 28 Apr 1816 Washington Co MD,¹⁰³ married Mary **Smith** 8 Feb 1849 Union Co OH; no children known to us. In 1850 he was a blacksmith (age 33) living on his parents' farm, Mill Creek Twp, Union Co.
7. Adam³ **Walley**, born 15 Jan 1819, married Nancy **Marks** -- [see page 13-13](#).
8. Samuel³ **Walley** was born 17 Jun 1821 Springfield Twp, Muskingum Co OH.¹⁰³ In 1850 he was a farmer (age 27), living on his parents' farm, Mill Creek Twp, Union Co OH. In 1860 he was still a farmer (age 38), living with wife Sarah (age 32) and mother Catherine (age 74), on the same farm, next door to brother William. He married Sarah **Conlay** 22 Aug 1877 Bates Co MO; no children known to us. He died about 1907 Bates Co, age about 86. We have no explanation for the apparent age discrepancies for Samuel's wife; we don't know whether he possibly had two wives named Sarah.

9. William³ **Walley**, born 28 Dec 1823, married Amanda **Deemer** -- see page 13-14.
10. Eliza Jane³ **Walley**, also known as Susan Jane Walley, was born 31 Jan 1826 Springfield Twp, Muskingum Co OH.¹⁰³ She married Gabriel **Leap** 10 Dec 1857 Union Co OH; no children known to us.
11. Sarah³ **Walley**, born 27 Sep 1829 Perry Twp, Franklin Co OH, married John **Inman** 2 Oct 1858 Union Co OH,¹⁰³ no children known to us.

Sarah Ann's parents were Matthias Wallick and Nancy Rohrer
 Jonas' parents were Johan Georg Itneyer and Elizabeth Beeler

7. Sarah Ann³ **Wallick**,¹⁴ born 15 Jan 1837 Washington Co MD, married Jonas **Itneyer** 21 Dec 1857 Trinity Reformed Church, Boonsboro, Washington Co;³² at least twelve children. He was born 12 Nov 1821. His parents were Johann Georg Itneyer and Elizabeth **Beeler**. Jonas was a farmer and wagonmaker, having learned from his father. He carried on the business with his brother William, in their shop in Boonsboro. After 1863 Jonas bought a 108 acre farm in Fiddlersburg, Washington Co. He eventually had 135 acres and built a fine brick home. Sarah died Boonsboro, but we don't know when. Jonas died 2 Dec 1897, age 76. They were buried Rose Hill Cemetery, Hagerstown MD.

THE ITNEYER FAMILY^{31,32} -- Johann Georg Itneyer, born 1 Mar 1787 Washington Co, had considerable property in Washington Co. He and Elizabeth Beeler had at least six children: Ruan; Sarah (married Jacob **Huzzel**, two children); William (married Catherine **Leiter**); Jacob (1818-1900, married Catherine **Wilkins**, eight children); Jonas; and Abraham.

- a) Laura Ann Elizabeth⁴ **Itneyer**, born 12 Oct 1858, married Joseph **Hoover**.
- b) George Howard⁴ **Itneyer**, born 1 Apr 1860, married Jennie **Williams**.
- c) Van Luther⁴ **Itneyer**, born 8 Sep 1861, married Emma **Boyd**.
- d) Nancy Mary⁴ "Molly" **Itneyer**, born 24 Jul 1863, married Samuel **Snyder**.
- e) John Jacob⁴ **Itneyer**, born 4 Dec 1864, married Pruda **Miller**.
- f) William Ragan⁴ **Itneyer**, born 1868, farmed the family homestead. He married Laura Virginia **Neff**; two children.
- g) Joseph Benjamin⁴ **Itneyer** was born 1870.

 Nancy's parents and birthdate are not known to us

H. Matthias² Wallick, born 25 Mar 1795 Washington Co MD,⁵ was christened 21 Jun 1795 Old Reformed Church, Funkstown, Washington Co. He may have served in the War of 1812 as a private in Capt George Shyrocks Company, 24th Regiment, Washington County militia. He married Nancy **Rohrer** 17 Apr 1818; seven children. She was born 1793. She may have been the widow of Jacob **Leckrone** (1786-1814), son of Jacob Leckrone Sr and Margaret **Schoenfelt** of Leitersburg, Washington Co.

1. Susanna³ **Wallick**⁴ was born 11 Jul 1818, and christened in Mar 1821 St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown, Washington Co MD.

We are curious about the delay between Susanna's birth and christening. We know parents were often unable to take their children into town for christening until some time after their births, but we note that Susanna was christened when George was 6 months old. We can't help wondering why they didn't take him when they took her instead of making two trips.

2. George³ **Wallick**,⁵ born 16 Sep 1820 Washington Co MD, was christened in Jun 1821 St Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown, Washington Co. He became a farmer near Boonsboro and Beaver Creek, Washington Co. He married Elizabeth A [Wallick].³⁷ He died 16 Mar 1885 Beaver Creek, age 64.¹⁴ Elizabeth was born about 1830; we don't know anything else about her.

Five children: Anna C about 1857; George Valentine about 1861; Nancy R about 1862; John H about 1865; James F about 1867; and Louisa about 1869.

3. Mary Ann³ **Wallick**,⁵ born 16 Mar 1825 Washington Co MD, married Henry **Lowry** 7 Jun 1849 Evangelical Lutheran Church, Waynesboro, Franklin Co PA; no children known to us. He was born about 1828. We don't know anything else about them.

4. John³ **Wallick**¹⁴ was probably born about 1830 Washington Co MD. In 1880 he may have been the uncle (age 50) in the household of George D and Amanda V **Shoop** in Antietam, Washington Co. We don't know anything else about John or the Shoop family.

5. William³ **Wallick**¹⁴ was born 1 Oct 1831 (date calculated from tombstone information). In 1850 he was a laborer in Washington Co MD. He married Elizabeth C **Long** 8 Jan 1853.²⁵ He died 19 Jun 1863 MD, age 31 years 8 months 18 days. Born 4 Apr 1825, Elizabeth died 2 Jul 1877, age 52.³⁵ They, their children, and their daughter-in-law were buried Boonsboro Cemetery, Boonsboro, Washington Co MD.

Two children: Luther C (1858-1936, married Annie E [Wallick] (1857-1933), son John W born 1887); and Alice S (1860-1902).

6. Rosanna³ **Wallick**,¹⁴ born about 1830-1842 Washington Co MD (age 28 in 1870 census³⁶), married Ezra **Moser**. He was born about 1841.

Three children: Jonas M about 1866; Nancy S about 1868; and William E about 1869.

7. Sarah Ann³ **Wallick**, born 15 Jan 1837 Washington Co MD, married Jonas **Itneyer**

2. Christian³ Wallich Jr, born about 1816, changed the spelling of his surname. He married Ariana Miller 6 Jan 1837 Baltimore City MD; five children. She was born 15 Jan 1809. Her parents were Jacob Miller (c1785-1863) and Ann Ricketts (c1791-1820). Christian died in 1890, age about 74. Ariana died 23 Aug 1893, age 84.

Edmonia Wallach Edler, KFE's grandmother, states in her memoirs that "Kris Wallach (sic) was a well-to-do and prosperous farmer of no mean standing" and "of a jovial disposition". His "Rolling Hill Farm" near Lisbon in Howard Co MD was well cared for though he had no slaves. "Given much to mirth and enjoyment", he also believed in hard work. She said his slogan was "not merely to wish for something, but to work hard until you get it".¹¹

A note by August Friedrich Wilhelm Edler, KFE's grandfather, indicates that Christian may have been a member of Rainbow Lodge No. 76, IOOF in the 5th Dist of Montgomery Co. The 1878 Hopkins map of Howard Co shows IOOF lodge 76 in Lisbon MD.

In the 1850 census, Christian and Ariana, with his sister Mary in their household, were living next to Ariana's brother, Jonathan Miller, in the Howard District of Montgomery Co. In the 1870 census, Christian and Ariana's household included their grandson William C Wallick, age 3. His father was their son John W, page 13-17; we don't know why William was with his grandparents. In the 1880 census, Christian and Ariana were in the household of their son Winfield Scott, page 13-22.

2. Zachariah³ **Walley**,^{99,100,104} born 1 Nov 1807 Conococheague Hundred, Washington Co MD, was christened 27 Aug 1808 St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hagerstown, Washington Co.⁴

He married Catherine Ann **Cryder** 22 Sep 1831 Delaware Co OH; at least eleven children (all except the oldest born Grundy Co IL). She was born 12 Dec 1814. Her parents were Henry Cryder and Mary Ann **Hess**. Catherine died 4 Feb 1849 Grundy Co, age 34, the day her last child was born.

Secondly, Zachariah married Eunice Louisa **Warren [Kellogg]** 6 Feb 1851 Nelson, Madison Co IL; at least two children. She was the widow of (--?--) Kellogg, with whom she probably had three children. She was born 3 Jun 1814 Madison Co NY. Her parents were Daniel Warren and Sarah **Lord**.

Zachariah died 5 Aug 1887 Grundy Co IL, age 79, buried Aux Sable Cemetery, Aux Sable, Grundy Co IL. Eunice died 17 Sep 1890 Grundy Co, age about 76.

Zachariah's parents had settled near Zanesville OH by 1821. Although they moved to Franklin Co OH by 1829, Zachariah evidently didn't go with them. Instead, he moved to Delaware Co OH on the Scioto River, probably about 1828 (year estimated based on other dates). He married there in 1831.

In Sep 1833, with his wife and oldest child, he moved from Delaware Co OH to Aux Sable, Grundy Co IL, in a three-family wagon caravan with the Cryder and Tabler families. They followed a compass course, arriving late October, and wintered in a communal log shelter which they built near a good spring. Altogether the three families had 8 oxen, several horses, and 15 cows. They were apparently the first white settlers on this spot, which had been much used by the Pottawatomie Indians.¹⁰⁴ We haven't identified the Tabler family.

In the 1850 census of Aux Sable, Zachariah's household was next door to his mother-in-law, which was next door to his brother-in-law. In Zachariah's household were his children Emily M (age 18), Mary A (14), Elizabeth (10), William (8), Susan A (7), Maria (5), Sarah E (3), and Minerva (1), plus John McGraw (age 14, born in VT, whom we haven't identified).

In the 1850 census of Wauponsee, Grundy Co, the household of "Eunice Kellogg" (age 36) included Mary E (age 14), Sarah J (5) and Synthia (age 3). Because of the nine-year difference between the ages of Mary and Sarah, we have wondered if Mr Kellogg was possibly Eunice's second husband.

In the 1860 census, Zachariah's household included himself, his wife Eunice, her daughter Cynthia (11), his children William (18), Susan (15), Maria (14), and Sarah E (12), and their children Catherine (5) and Antis (2).

The biggest 'mystery' concerning Zachariah's family has to do with his son LeRoy, page 11, whose mother we haven't been able to identify. Catherine died 4 Feb 1849, LeRoy was born 18 Dec 1849, and Zachariah married Eunice 6 Feb 1851. LeRoy isn't in the household of either Zachariah or Eunice in 1850. Perhaps he was a relative's child, and Zachariah took him in after 1850. In the cemetery listing LeRoy is identified as a son of Zachariah and Eunice. Another possibility is that LeRoy may have been a son, possibly illegitimate, of Zachariah's daughter Emily, who died 4 Oct 1852, age about 20. We doubt we will ever know, but it has been interesting to wonder.

- a. Emily M⁴ **Walley**¹⁰⁴ was born about 1832 in OH. She died 4 Oct 1852 Grundy Co IL, age about 20, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.
- b. (--?--)⁴ **Walley** was born 11 Apr 1834. She died 15 Apr 1834, age four days, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.
- c. Mary A⁴ **Walley**, born about 1836 (age 14 in 1850), probably died before 1860, because she isn't shown in that census. She was buried Aux Sable Cemetery; death date unreadable in cemetery listing.

d. (--?--)⁴ **Walley** was born 28 Jan 1837. She died 3 Feb 1837, age six days, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.
 e. Henry G⁴ **Walley**⁹² was born 4 Aug 1838. He died 9 Sep 1838 Aux Sable, age five weeks, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.

f. Elizabeth C⁴ **Walley**,^{89,104} born about 1840, married Frederick J **Beane**; three children: Arthur L about 1865 Kendall Co IL; Wallace C "Walley" Apr 1867; and Etta Eva about 1870. Frederick was born about 1826 in England. Elizabeth died about 1874, age about 34.

g. William A⁴ **Walley**,¹⁰⁴ born 3 May 1842, married Louisa E **Pyle** 23 Feb 1869 in IL; four children. She was born 18 Mar 1843. Her parents were Enos Pyle and Matilda **Harry**. Louisa died 2 Jul 1916, age 73. William died 11 Apr 1920 Walley homestead, age 77.⁷⁹ They were buried Aux Sable Cemetery.⁹²

William and his father were described as "republicans". William bought and lived on the family homestead after his father's death. William served as a road commissioner for some years, as Justice of the Peace, and as president of the Grundy County Farm Bureau when it was first organized.

i. Bertha E⁵ **Walley**^{89,104} married Thomas E **Leach** 9 Jul 1889 Will Co IL.
 Five children: Fred E, Ruth L, Theodore A, Edith A, and Grace C.

ii. Frederick E⁵ **Walley**^{92,99} was born about 1873 Grundy Co IL. He died 7 Nov 1877 Grundy Co, age about four.

iii. William Cryder⁵ **Walley**,^{92,104} born in 1878, married Helen **Todd** 25 May 1910. She died 6 Oct 1925. He died 14 Dec 1944, age about 66, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.
 One child: Clara Louise, married Henry **Stallwitz**.

iv. Grace A⁵ **Walley**⁹² was born in 1882. She died in 1883, age probably about one year.

h. Susan Ann⁴ **Walley**,^{89,104} born 12 Mar 1843, married John **McKanna** 1 May 1862 Grundy Co; five children born Kendall Co IL. He was born 19 Jun 1827 New York state. She died 29 Mar 1902 Seward, Kendall Co, age 59. He died 7 Nov 1904, age 77. They were buried Aux Sable Cemetery.

i. Winfield Scott⁵ **McKanna** was born 1867. He died 28 Oct 1950 Kendall Co IL, age about 83.

ii. Emma⁵ **McKanna** was born about 1869.

iii. Mary Frances⁵ **McKanna** was born 10 Dec 1872. She died 11 May 1916, age 43.

iv. Gertrude⁵ **McKanna** was born 24 Jan 1874. She died 4 Sep 1963, age 91.

v. Bessie⁵ **McKanna** was born about 1879.

i. Maria Eliza⁴ **Walley**,^{89,104} born 19 Mar 1845, married Peter Houston **Davis** 19 Feb 1868 Seward Twp, Kendall Co IL; four children. He was born 18 Jan 1840 Orange Co NY. She died 30 Jun 1917 Kendall Twp, Kendall Co, age 72. He died 17 Dec 1917, age 77, less than six months after Maria.

i. Mary Elizabeth⁵ **Davis**, born 19 Jun 1873 Kendall Co, married Joseph M **Austin**; no children known to us. She died Jun 1972 Grundy Co IL, age 99 or almost 99.

ii. Walley Hurd⁵ **Davis**, born 20 Sep 1878, married Fanny **Wheeler** Kane Co IL; two children.

iii. Clarence C⁵ **Davis**, born 4 Jul 1882, married Madeline A **Hampson** 1909, and married Signe Colleen [Davis] about 1918; no children known to us. He died Jun 1983 Kendall Co, age almost 101.

iv. Floyd I⁵ **Davis** was born 12 Mar 1888. He died 16 Dec 1918 Chicago IL, age 30.

- j.** Sarah E⁴ **Walley**,¹⁰⁴ born about 1846, married Henry **Netherton**; no children known to us. He was born about 1838. She died about 1920, age about 64. He died about 1924, age about 86.
- k.** Minerva⁴ **Walley** was born 4 Feb 1849, the day her mother died. Minerva died 28 Feb 1851, age two, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.
- l)** LeRoy A⁴ **Walley**⁹² was born 18 Dec 1849 Aux Sable. He died 17 Sep 1854 Aux Sable, age four, buried Aux Sable Cemetery. His father's first wife had died 4 Feb 1849, and his father didn't marry his second wife until 6 Feb 1851, so we don't know who was LeRoy's mother.
- m.** Catharine A⁴ **Walley**,¹⁰⁴ born about 1855 (age five in 1860), married Thomas **Hague**; two children: Ira Z, and Jessie (married George **Barnett**).
- n.** Antis Z⁴ **Walley**^{92,104} was born 17 Apr 1858 Aux Sable. He died 23 Jan 1875 Aux Sable, age 16, in a hunting accident, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.

In the 1860 census, James Snyder, age 20, is shown in his father Joseph's household in Damascus/Unity PO MD. Also in the household were James' younger sister Amanda, who married John W Wallich, page 13-17, and James' younger brother Frederick, first husband of Catherine Simpson whose second husband was Winfield Scott Wallich, page 13-22.

In the 1870 census, Mary and her son Lewis, age 4, are shown in her parents' household, along with her nephew William, age 3, son of John W Wallich.

In the 1880 census, Mary and Lewis, age 14, were in the household of her brother Winfield Scott Wallich, along with her nephew William, age 13, son of John W Wallich, and Christian Wallich Jr and Ariana Miller, the parents of Winfield and Mary.

At some later time, Mary and Lewis established a farm in Howard Co MD.

- i)** James Lewis⁵ **Snyder**, usually known as Lewis, was born about 1866 (age 4 in 1870). He died about 1951, age about 86, buried Christ Church, Howard Co.
 One child: James Lewis Jr, born about 1904, died about 1991, age about 87. His daughter Nancy married Ben **Stevens**. She has helped us with some family information.

3. George Alvin³ **Walley**,^{100,103} born 30 Sep 1810 Conococheague Hundred, Washington Co MD, married Elizabeth **Thomas** 8 Sep 1832 Dublin, Franklin Co OH; eleven children.⁹² She was born 2 Jul 1814 in OH. Her parents were John Thomas and Mary [Thomas].

George is shown as a farmer in 1850 and 1860 censuses. He and Elizabeth lived in Grundy Co IL, at least from 1841 to 1848. Sometime later, they moved to Bates Co MO, possibly in or near Amsterdam. About 1859, his parents came to live with them, but his father died not long afterwards and his mother may have moved back to Union Co OH.

George died 8 Dec 1862 Bates Co, age 52, after an accident. Elizabeth died 14 May 1897, age 82. They were buried Walley Cemetery, Bates Co MO.

Sadly, we note that of eleven children, only four grew to adulthood. Of the seven who died, five were less than two years old. We don't know what happened, but there may have been an epidemic in 1846, when two died a month apart, and again in 1854 when two died only four days apart.

a. Irvin⁴ "Cap" **Walley**, born 7 Dec 1833, married Mary [Walley] about 1865. He was a farmer. In 1870 his household in Butler, Bates Co MO, included Mary, age 23, and daughters Birdie and Bettie. All we know about Mary is that she was born about 1846 in VA. He died 28 Apr 1894, age 60.

b. Armenis H⁴ **Walley** was born 28 Apr 1836. He died 2 Sep 1846 Grundy Co IL, age 10, buried Aux Sable Cemetery, Aux Sable, Grundy Co.

c. Almira⁴ **Walley**, born 5 May 1838, married George **Boyer**; no children known to us.

d. Mary Elizabeth⁴ **Walley** was born 29 Jul 1840. She died 27 Sep 1840 Grundy Co IL, age two months.

e. Mary Jane⁴ **Walley** was born 2 Nov (or 2 Oct) 1841 Grundy Co IL. She died 14 May 1842 Grundy Co, age five or six months.

f. Oliver B⁴ **Walley** was born 3 Mar 1843 Grundy Co IL. He died 1 Oct 1843 Grundy Co, age almost seven months, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.

g. Isabel⁴ **Walley** was born 16 Dec 1844 Grundy Co IL. She died 2 Oct 1846 Grundy Co, age 21 months, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.

h. Alvin George⁴ **Walley**, born 24 Apr 1848, married Rebecca Ann **Huffman** -- see page 13-23.

i. Silas C⁴ **Walley** was born 10 Apr 1850 Grundy Co IL. He died 17 Aug 1854 Grundy Co, age four, buried Aux Sable Cemetery.

j. John R⁴ **Walley** was born 17 Aug 1852 Grundy Co IL. He died 13 Aug 1854 Grundy Co, age almost two years.

k. Emma I⁴ **Walley**, born 21 Oct 1854 Grundy Co IL, married (--?--) **Potter**; no children known to us.

7. Adam³ **Walley**, born 15 Jan 1819 Washington Co MD, married Nancy **Marks** 18 Jul 1838 Delaware Co OH; three children. She was born 29 Jun 1816 in VA. Her parents were John Marks and Lydia **Wellen**.

Adam and Nancy moved from Ohio to Illinois in 1843. He died 26 Oct 1846 Grundy Co IL, age 27. Nancy died 5 Nov 1898 Clear Lake IA, age 82.

a. Jerome Augustus⁴ **Walley**, born 28 Dec 1839, entered military service 14 Jul 1862, enlisting in Co C, 76th Illinois Infantry. He died 26 Apr 1865 Mound City, Pulaski Co IL, age 25, of an unspecified disease. He was first buried at Mound City, where he had died; was reinterred in Moyer Burying Ground, Mazon, Grundy Co IL; and again reinterred in Evergreen Cemetery, Soldiers' Lot, Morris, Grundy Co.

We are interested in Jerome because we think it is especially sad when soldiers die from disease.

Mound City is in the southernmost part of IL, on the Ohio River. His mother probably lived in Grundy Co, which is southwest of Chicago. We think she probably went, or sent someone, to bring his body back from Mound City (families who could afford it often did that). But we have no explanation for moving him from Mazon to Morris, which isn't very far away. We haven't found a "Moyer Burying Ground".

The 76th Illinois Infantry wasn't anywhere near Mound City IL in April 1865, so we assume Jerome became ill in the south and was taken to a hospital in Mound City. The 76th lost 52 killed or mortally wounded, 167 wounded or missing, and 207 dead from disease. Jerome's enlistment would have been up 22 Jul 1865, less than 3 months after he died.

b. Mary Catherine⁴ **Walley**, born 14 May 1841, married John G **Parker** 14 Jun 1860; at least two children: Alice (age 8 in 1870) and Almeda (age 5 in 1870). They lived in Wauponsee Twp, Grundy Co IL in 1870, and Clear Lake IA in 1898.

c. Almira Melissa⁴ **Walley**, born 30 Jul 1842, married William F **Brayton** 30 Jun 1863 Morris, Grundy Co IL; four children, of whom three lived to adulthood. In 1898 she was living Oregon City OR. She died 18 Jan 1923 Baytown TX, age 80.

i. Alzina Miranda⁵ **Brayton** had seven children. She became the grandmother of Donna D **Kellog [Parks]**, who has been most helpful with family information.

ii. Elsie Mary⁵ **Brayton** had five children.

iii. Myo Lee⁵ **Brayton** had three children. We aren't sure if Myo was a man or woman.

9. William³ **Walley**^{100,101,103} was born 28 Dec 1823 Springfield Twp, Muskingum Co OH. In 1850 he was a farmer, living on his parents' farm in Mill Creek Twp, Union Co OH. Later he became an ordained minister in the Ohio Central Christian Conference. He served as deacon of the Christian Church in Watkins, Mill Creek Twp from 30 Jun 1849 until 26 Mar 1859. In 1864 he was a Justice of the Peace.

He married Amanda **Deemer** 25 Feb 1850 Union Co; two children born in OH. She was born 28 May 1829 Union Co. Her parents were Abraham Deemer (born 1798 in OH?) and Maria [Deemer] (born about 1807 in PA).

Amanda died 15 May 1865 Union Co, age almost 36. William died 13 Dec 1869 Jerome Twp, Union Co, age 45. They were buried Old Jerome/Herriott Cemetery, near Jerome, Union Co (on the north side of Brock Road, one mile west of Jerome Road, coordinates 400946 north, 0831035 west).⁵⁷

a. William Edgar⁴ **Walley**¹⁰⁰ was born about 1855 (age 5 in 1860 census, age 15 in 1870 living with his grandparents).⁵³ He died near Decatur, Wise Co TX, accidentally shot by a young boy who mistook him at night for a Comanche Indian. We don't know when this happened.

b. Irwin Wilmore⁴ **Walley**,¹⁰⁰ born 8 Mar 1857,^{44,45} married Flora Belle **Merryman** about 1881 Delaware Co OH. She was born 12 Jun 1861. Her parents were Henson Merryman and Mary [Merryman].

Irwin was a master stone and brick mason. He was a well respected worker and contractor for many large masonry projects in north Texas, such as the foundation of the Hood Co Courthouse in Granbury TX, various schoolhouses, and many buttresses and trestle supports for the Denver, Texas and Rio Grande Railroad.^{40,100}

He died 8 Aug 1911, age 54. Flora Belle died 29 Jan 1929, age 67. They were buried Granbury (College Hill) Cemetery, Granbury.⁴⁵

Five children: William Gale Apr 1883; Bessie M May 1884; Forest Henson Oct 1886; Mary A Jul 1888; and Inez M Sep 1889.

i. William Gale⁵ **Walley**,⁴² born Apr 1883 in OH (age 17 in 1900 census, 37 in 1910),⁴⁰ married Elizabeth [Walley] in TX. In 1930 he was a rural mail carrier in Hood Co TX.⁴¹

Four children born in TX: Irvin about 1911; William Gale Jr about 1915; Mary E about 1917; and Helen M about 1922.

ii. Forest Henson⁵ **Walley**, born 7 Oct 1886 in TX,^{40,104} married Minnie Lee **McDowell** 16 Aug 1908 Granbury, Hood Co TX.⁴⁰ She was born 16 Mar 1890. Her parents were John Eugene McDowell and Rhoda Ann **Hendon**. In 1920 Forest was a farmer in Hood Co. Minnie died Nov 1976 in TX, age 86.³⁸

Three children: Merryman about 1913 (age 7 in 1920 census); Barnadine about 1915 (age 5 in 1920); and Raymond about 1917.

a) Forrest Raymond⁶ **Walley**, usually known as Raymond,³⁹ was born 22 Jun 1917 Granbury, Hood Co TX. He married Georgia Lee **Shepherd** 17 May 1942 Lon Morris College, Dr Peeples' residence, Jacksonville, Childress Co TX;¹⁰⁴ one son. She was born 8 Oct 1921 in TX. Raymond died Jul 1974, age 57.³⁸

1. Joseph³ **Wallick**, born 5 Mar 1822 Washington Co MD, was a farmer in Antietam, Washington Co MD. He married Mary Elizabeth **Troup** 23 Mar 1869 Harrisburg, Dauphin Co PA; two children. Born 6 Oct 1832, she died 4 Sep 1899, age 66. He died 21 Dec 1903 Hagerstown, Washington Co, age 81. They were buried Rose Hill Cemetery, Hagerstown.

a. Ida Mae⁴ **Wallick** was born 28 Jul 1870 in MD. She died 1 Apr 1925, age 54, buried Rose Hill Cemetery, Hagerstown.⁵

b. Harry Willis⁴ **Wallick**, born 22 Apr 1873, married Elizabeth B **Zimmerman** in 1898; six children born Washington Co MD. She was born 1 Sep 1878. He died 10 Mar 1925 on his farm near Hagerstown, Washington Co MD, age 51. She died 15 Feb 1962, age 83. They were buried Rose Hill Cemetery, Hagerstown.⁵

i. Edythe Viola⁵ **Wallick** was born 20 Oct 1900. She died 28 Sep 1901, age 11 months, buried Rose Hill Cemetery, Hagerstown.⁵

ii. John Edward⁵ **Wallick** was born 30 Apr 1903. In 1930 he was a farmer in Washington Co. He married Ruth Esther **Horst**; son John Jr. She was born 7 May 1900. John Sr died 25 May 1954 Chewsville, Garrett Co MD, age 51. Ruth Esther died 12 Jul 1971, age 71.

iii. Clarence Elmer⁵ **Wallick** was born 25 Mar 1905. He died 15 Jul 1911 Hagerstown, age six.

iv. Mary Blanche⁵ **Wallick**, born 11 May 1910, married William **Gearhart**. Born about 1905, he died 13 Apr 1969, age 64. She died 22 Nov 1996, age 86. They were buried Rose Hill Cemetery.

One child: William Jr, born 27 Dec 1928, died 18 Mar 1993 Washington Co MD, age 64.

v. Ruth Jane⁵ **Wallick**, born 28 Oct 1915, married Jacob Parker **Green** 8 Feb 1935. He was born 1 Feb 1910. His parents were Luther Green and Mabel **Leatherman**. Their other son Harry Luther married Ruth's sister Ethel Irene. Jacob died 19 Sep 1986, age 76. Ruth died 22 Mar 2001 West Jefferson, Madison Co OH, age 85. They were buried Memorial Gardens, Hagerstown.

One child: Judith, married Mr **Arganbright** and has been helpful with family information.

vi. Ethel Irene⁵ **Wallick** was born 28 Dec 1917 Wallick Farm, Washington Co MD (located off Northern Avenue, North Hagerstown, behind shopping center). He was born 27 Jul 1838 Leitersburg, Washington Co. His parents were Jacob Baer Lehman Sr and Barbara **Funk**. Jacob Jr died 3 Mar 1910 Washington Co, age 71. Mahala died 26 Jul 1913 Washington Co, age 75 (or 26 Jul 1936, age 98). They were buried Rose Hill Cemetery, Washington Co.

THE LEHMAN FAMILY -- Jacob Baer Lehman Sr was born 28 Feb 1805, Rohrstown, Lancaster Co PA. Barbara Funk was born 3 Mar 1809 Franklin Co PA. They were married 15 Apr 1828 Rohrstown. He died 4 Aug 1866 Washington Co MD, age 61. She died 18 May 1872 Washington Co, age 63. They were buried Longmeadows Cemetery, Washington Co.

a. Gertrude⁴ "Gertie" Lehman was born about 1871.

b. Charles F⁴ Lehman, born about 1872 in MD, married Ada V **Hartman** about 1898. She was born about 1876 in MD. In 1930, age 58, he was a salesman, general merchandise, in Leitersburg.

c. Walter E⁴ Lehman, born Oct 1876 Washington Co MD, married Pearl **Myers** in Mar 1902 Huron Co OH. She was born about 1881 in OH. Walter died 21 Aug 1948 Richland Co OH, age 71, buried Oakland Cemetery, Shelby, Richland Co.

Nine children: Jacob Paul (1903 Hagerstown MD, died 1967 Shelby OH); Meredith D (1904 Greenwich OH, died 1986 Barberton OH); Maurice C (1906); Blanche Lucille (about 1908); Ruth M (1909-1995 OH); Dorothy (1911, married Ralph **Cadwell**, she died 1998 Tucson AZ); and Robert, Thelma, and Velma, whose birthdates we don't know.

b) John W⁴ Wallich, born 1840 Howard Co MD, was a farmer. He married Amanda J Snyder 21 Nov 1865 at the residence of her father, Joseph Snyder, Montgomery Co MD (signed by Rev G W Burns, officiant⁹⁵); at least three children. She was born about 1847.

In 1868 John was on the voter list, 5th district, Howard Co, registered by certificate from Montgomery Co,⁹⁶ so we think he and Amanda probably moved to Howard Co not long after their marriage.

We also think they may have moved back to Montgomery Co after a short time, because John (age 29), Amanda (age 26), and Katie J (age five months) are shown in the household of her father Joseph in the 1870 census of Montgomery Co. It's possible, of course, that they were simply visiting when the census was taken. We assume Amanda died after 1874 and before 1877.

Secondly, John married Warnetta A Ayton 25 Sep 1877 Montgomery Co MD; at least one child. She was born 1842. In the Montgomery Co 1880 census, in John's household are his wife Warnetta and his two daughters, plus his aunt Mary Wallick, page 13-2, and Amanda's father Joseph. This makes us think John may have taken over Joseph's farm at some time after 1870. We can't be sure, however, because the census districts in 1870 and 1880 were slightly different (perhaps only a change in terminology) and, of course, it's possible Joseph was visiting them when the census was taken.

Later in the 1880s, John was a grocer in Washington DC at several addresses (including, in 1891, 44 L Street NW).⁹⁴ We don't know when he or Warnetta died.

John is shown as a child of Ariana Miller [Wallich] in the record of 10 Mar 1894 distribution of proceeds of the sale of dower rights of Mary Burdette [Miller], page 13-8.

We haven't been able to find why John's oldest child, William C Wallich, isn't listed in John's household in any of the census records we have found. Perhaps William was illegitimate, since he was born after his father's marriage to Amanda. In any case, it appears that neither Amanda nor Warnetta acted as a mother or stepmother for William.

i) William C⁵ **Wallich**¹⁰ was born about 1867. In the 1870 census (age 3) he was in the household of his father's parents. In the 1880 census (age 13), he was in the household of his uncle Winfield Scott Wallich.

William married Annie E [Wallich] about 1887. In the 1900 census (age 33) he was a carpenter, living in Washington DC with his wife and three children: Blanche L (age 9), Russell G (age 4), and Gladys O (age four months). Edward **McCauley** (age 75) was also in the household, shown as an uncle, but we haven't identified him.

ii) Catherine I⁵ “Catie/Kate” **Wallich**,¹⁰ was born about Jan 1870 (age five months in 1870, age 10 in 1880).⁹⁷

iii) Ida M⁵ **Wallich**¹⁰ was born about 1874 (age 6 in 1880).

iv) John Ephraim⁵ **Wallich**⁹⁴ was born 11 Nov 1878 in MD (based on age at death). He died 29 Jul 1879, age 8 months, 16 days.⁹⁸

THE BOWMAN FAMILY -- George Washington Bowman and Eleanor Young had six children, including William C (married Annie R Wallich, above), Rezin W (married Clara Elizabeth "Carrie" Allnutt, below), and Marcella Augusta (married James Edward Wallach, page 13-19).

Parents of George Washington Bowman were Aden Bowman and Keziah **Sedgwick**. They also had son William H Bowman, who married Sarah **Miller**, sister of Ariana Miller (mother of Annie R Wallich). Sarah and Ariana were daughters of Jacob Miller and Ann Ricketts.

George died 12 Sep 1929, age almost 78. They were buried Mt Tabor Methodist Cemetery, Etchison MD.

Two children: Annie G (20 Jul 1884) and William W (1886-1962).

ii) Maurice E⁵ Bowman,⁸⁴ born 8 Mar 1867 in MD, married Martha A **Hawkins**; no children known to us. She was born 29 Jul 1865. Her parents were Thomas Hawkins (1817-1875) and Susan **Clagett** (1823-1905), whose son George married Maurice's sister Ida. Maurice died 25 Feb 1927, age 59. Martha died 4 Dec 1935, age 70. iii) Clinton⁵ Bowman, born 18 May 1869 in MD, married Clara Elizabeth "Carrie" **Allnutt [Bowman]**; no children known to us. She was born 27 Aug 1873. Her parents were John Benjamin Allnutt and Ann Maria **Marlow**, Section 12a, whose son Henry married Clinton's sister Clara, below.

Carrie was the widow of Clinton's uncle, Rezin W Bowman. Rezin was a brother of Clinton's father William C Bowman. Rezin and William were sons of George Washington Bowman and Eleanor Young.

Clinton died 1 Apr 1938, age 68. Carrie died 7 Mar 1971, age 97. They were buried Goshen Methodist Cemetery, Goshen, Montgomery Co MD.^{60,85}

iv) Clara E⁵ Bowman,⁶⁰ born about 1873 (age 6 in 1880 census),^{87,88} married Henry C **Allnutt** 24 Dec 1894 Montgomery Co MD. He was born 22 Apr 1871. His parents were John Benjamin Allnutt and Ann Maria **Marlow**, Section 12a, whose daughter Carrie married Clara's uncle Rezin and married Clara's brother Clinton, above. Henry died 8 Jun 1915, age 44. Clara died about 1936, age about 63. They were buried Laytonsville, Montgomery Co MD.⁸⁸

Three children: Albert B, Cecil B, and Clara E, Section 12a.

d) James Edward⁴ Wallich was born 8 Jan 1845 Lisbon, Howard Co MD (or, some say he was born in Jan 1849³). He was a miller in Montgomery Co MD, later a farmer and carpenter.¹²

He married Marcella Augusta **Bowman** 19 Dec 1867;²⁴ two children. She was born about 1850. Her parents were George Washington Bowman and Eleanor **Young**. Marcella died 13 Aug 1874 Laytonsville, Montgomery Co, age about 24. She was buried on the farm of her grandfather Aden Bowman, but the actual site is lost because the graves were ploughed under in 1948.

James married Anna Rebecca Bennett 28 Nov 1875; eight children born Germantown, Montgomery Co. She was born 19 Nov 1854. Her parents were Richard Henry Bennett and Savilla Miller. James' mother Ariana and Anna Rebecca's mother Savilla were half-sisters, so James and Anna Rebecca were first cousins.

Anna Rebecca's sister, Martha Jane T Bennett, married Anna Rebecca's stepson Basil Crawford Wallich, son of James Edward Wallich and his first wife Marcella Augusta Bowman, page 13-24.

We don't know when or why Anna Rebecca changed the spelling of her married surname, and the spelling of her children's surname, from Wallich to Wallach. As far as we know, James retained the spelling Wallich.

James died 16 Dec 1926 Rockville, Montgomery Co, age 81. Anna Rebecca died 18 Nov 1930, age 76.⁵⁹ They were buried Baptist Cemetery, Germantown, Montgomery Co.

We (KFE and BFE) were privileged to meet Stanley at the 1996 Wallick reunion in Terra Alta WV of about 35 of his descendants.⁷² He said grace for the meal. At age 91 he was alert and spoke interestingly of his youth, courtship and work. He said that he grew up on a small farm and farming was "all he knew". Later he worked as manager of the 500+ acre Enterprise Farm in central Prince George's Co MD, for many years. When he retired, the farm was sold for use as a country club/golf course. He also told that he and his brother Elwood Wallich married two Gore sisters. He said that since he didn't have a car of his own at the time, he went along with his older brother. Robert Ellis' lifelong hobby was collecting model trains, and he established a toy train museum in Harper's Ferry about 1970.
